The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of June, 2012.

(June 1: Friday)

An Officer conducting route foot patrol of the Grand Pavilion area observed a subject that appeared to be under the legal age of 21 carrying an open container of beer. After positively identifying the subject, and confirming his age, the subject was charged with Underage Possession of Alcohol.

(June 2: Saturday)

An Officer observed two male subjects at the 35th Avenue beach access consuming alcoholic beverages. Both subjects were placed under arrest and charged accordingly.

Officers responded to the front beach in reference to a fight in progress. Upon arrival, it was determined that a verbal argument escalated to a physical altercation when one of the subjects struck the other, with a closed fist, in the face. The primary aggressor was placed under arrest and charged with Disorderly Conduct, as the victim did not wish to pursue charges.

(June 3: Sunday)

Officers were dispatched to a single vehicle accident in the 2200 block of Palm Boulevard. According to the reporting Officer, the vehicle had swerved across the roadway, at what appeared to be at a high rate of speed, struck a palm tree and continued across a ditch and finally came to a stop when striking a fence and heavy vegetation; approximately 40 feet from the roadway. Through investigation, it was determined that the driver, and sole occupant of the vehicle, was Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol (DUI). She was placed under arrest and charged accordingly after receiving medical treatment for her injuries.

An Officer conducting route patrol of the Municipal Parking lot observed two subjects sleeping in a vehicle. Through investigation, it was determined that one of the subjects had an active NRVC (Failure to Pay a Traffic Ticket). Both subjects were charged with sleeping in a vehicle, with the second subject also being charged with the NRVC.

(June 4: Monday)

Officers responded to the Recreation Department in reference to an attempted Arson. The complainant reported that there were a number of burnt matches located on the floor, cabinet and toilet of one of the facilities restrooms. The case was assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division. During follow-up investigation, a suspect developed and was subsequently arrested.

An Officer conducted a lawful traffic stop in the 2000 block of Palm Boulevard. During interview, it was determined that one of the occupants was intoxicated, as well as under the legal age of 21. The subject was detained, charged and released to her parents.

(June 7: Thursday)

An Officer conducted a traffic stop in the 2500 block of Palm Boulevard. The operator of the vehicle was placed under arrest after it was learned that his driver's license was suspended. A pre-tow inventory of the vehicle produced a quantity of a green, plant-like material that field tested presumptive positive for Tetrahydrocannibannol (THC ,the active ingredient in marijuana).

(June 9: Saturday)

An Officer conducted a traffic stop on Waterway Boulevard at Duck Lane. While speaking with the driver, the Officer observed an open container of alcohol inside the vehicle. The subject was placed under arrest for Open Container of Liquor. A pre-tow inventory of the subjects' vehicle produced a quantity of a green, plant-like material that field tested presumptive positive for Tetrahydrocannibannol (THC, the active ingredient in marijuana).

Two white male subjects, who appeared to be intoxicated, were located walking along the 1900 block of Palm Boulevard. By the time the Officer could get his vehicle turned around and back to their location, one of the subjects had fled the scene. During interview of the remaining subject, it was determined that he was grossly intoxicated, consequently placed under arrest.

A subject was observed stealing the street sign located at Ocean Boulevard and J. C. Long Boulevard. Officers were able to locate the subject, as well as the sign. The subject was charged with Petit Larceny.

(June 10: Sunday)

During a traffic stop in the 800 block of Palm Boulevard, it was determined that the operator of the vehicle did not possess a valid driver's license.

(June 18: Monday)

An Officer conducted a traffic stop in the 800 block of Palm Boulevard. While speaking with the driver, the Officer recognized the passenger to be intoxicated and appeared to be under the legal age of 21. After confirming the passengers age, she was charged with Under Age Possession of Alcohol.

During a traffic stop in the 1400 block of Palm Boulevard, an Officer observed an open container of alcohol. The operator of the vehicle was charged accordingly.

(June 19: Tuesday)

An Officer conducted a traffic stop in the 1100 block of Ocean Boulevard. While interviewing the operator, it was determined that he did not possess a driver's license. Consequently, the subject was placed under arrest.

A traffic stop was conducted at the Isle of Palms Marina. It was learned that the operator of the vehicle had a suspended driver's license. The subject was placed under arrest.

(June 20: Wednesday)

Officers responded to a complaint of a possible underage party in the 3000 block of Waterway Boulevard. Upon making contact with the subjects inside the residence, it was determined that 12 subjects attending the party were under the age of 21. All 12 subjects were charged with Underage Possession of Alcohol. While at the residence, Officers observed two street signs belonging to the City of Isle of Palms. It was determined who stole the signs and the subject was consequently charged with Petit Larceny.

(June 22: Friday)

An Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for displaying a suspended license plate. The operator was placed under arrest and was charged accordingly.

A lawful traffic stop was conducted on the Isle of Palms Connector. It was determined that the operator of the vehicle was doing so with a suspended driver's license. He was placed under arrest and charged with DUS.

A traffic stop was conducted on a golf cart on Palmetto Drive near Beachwood West. The operator was placed under arrest for Driving Under Suspension (DUS).

(June 23: Saturday)

Officers were dispatched to the dock area of a local business in reference to a domestic dispute. Upon arrival, the couple was located with the male subject being observed as intoxicated. He was placed under arrest and charged with Public Intoxication.

(June 24: Sunday)

Officers responded to a local business in reference to a disturbance. Upon arrival, Officers made contact with a white male and a white female subject, both of whom were intoxicated. Through interview, it was learned that the female subject struck the male subject. The female subject was placed under arrest. A pre-tow inventory of her vehicle produced a quantity of a green, plant-like material which field-tested presumptive positive for Tetrahydrocannibannol (THC ,the active ingredient in marijuana).

Officers responded to a residence in the 4000 block of Hartnett Boulevard in reference to a domestic dispute. After positively identifying the subjects, information returned that one of the subjects had an active warrant out of the Mount Pleasant Police Department (MPPD) for traffic offenses. The subject was placed under arrest and turned over to the MPPD.

An Officer responded to the Municipal Parking lot in reference to a dispute. Information returned on the person of interest that he had an active bench warrant for Failure to Pay a Traffic Fine. The subject was placed under arrest.

(June 27: Wednesday)

Officers were dispatched to 42^{nd} Avenue in reference to a fire and disturbance. Upon arrival, Officers observed a substance on fire in the middle of the road in front of 642^{nd} Avenue. The Isle of Palms Fire Department arrived on scene and extinguished the fire. Upon preliminary investigation, Fire

Department personnel determined the fire to be of a suspicious nature. The Criminal Investigations Division was summoned to the scene. An investigation of the crime scene produced evidence that an improvised explosive device (IED) had been detonated. Suspects have developed and leads are being pursued.

(June 29: Friday)

During a traffic stop on Palmetto Drive, it was learned that the registration to the suspect vehicle was expired and the operator's driver's license was suspended. The subject was placed under arrest and charged with Driving Under Suspension (DUS) and having an Expired Registration.

(June 30: Saturday)

An Officer conducted a traffic stop at Palm Boulevard and Charleston Boulevard. During interview with the operator, it was determined that his driver's license was suspended.

While on foot patrol on Ocean Boulevard, an Officer observed two subjects possessing open containers of beer. Both subjects were placed under arrest and charged with Open Container of Alcohol on Street.

An Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle on Palmetto Drive at Racquet Club Road. The operator of the vehicle was arrested for Driving Under Suspension.

Officers were dispatched to a local business in reference to a disturbance. Upon arrival, Officers made contact with the complainant (owner) who stated that an intoxicated male was being belligerent and refusing to leave the establishment after being advised to do so. The subject was located and placed under arrest for Disorderly Conduct.

<u>Patrol</u>

During the month of June, 2012, Officers issued 27 Business Check notices to business owners/employees advising them that the business was found unsecure. There were 31 Victim of Crime forms completed.
