Isle of Palms Fire Department Call Summary Report January 2013

- 1/2/13 Personnel responded to a mutual aid structure fire on Rifle Range Road in Awendaw. Upon arrival, personnel were assigned as the Rapid Intervention Team while fire suppression operations were taking place. Once the incident was brought under control, personnel were asked to standby at Awendaw Fire Station No. 5 to cover until their units could be returned to service.
- 1/12/13 Personnel responded to a condominium complex on Palmetto Drive for a report of three people stuck inside a stopped elevator car. Upon arrival, personnel met with the maintenance staff who directed the crew to the second floor. The crew used their elevator keys to open the exterior doors and gain access to the individuals inside the car. The victims were helped from the car and required no further assistance. Maintenance personnel advised they had already contacted the elevator repair company and they were enroute. All units returned to service.
- 1/19/13 Personnel responded to a possible structure fire on 24th Avenue. Upon arrival, the crew found a fire in the kitchen that had already been extinguished. The source of the fire was a pot that had been left on the stove. The pot was removed from the building, the power to the stove was secured at the breaker, and the resident was advised to have the stove inspected prior to using it again. All units returned to service.
