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Isle of Palms Fire Department Call Summary May 2013

5/3/13 Personnel responded to Awendaw Fire Department Station No. 1 for a standby. Engine 1001 responded and stood by in station while crews from Awendaw extinguished a structure fire. 5/3/13 Personnel responded to the Intracoastal Waterway after receiving a report of an individual having difficulty in the water. After about 30 minutes of searching both Fire Department jet skis were recalled due to darkness and Boat 1020 was launched. Charleston County Rescue also was called at this time to assist with the search. The U.S. Coast Guard, the Charleston County Sheriff's Office, and the North Charleston Fire Department all assisted with searching the areas from Breach Inlet to the Charleston Harbor, and also through the air over the entire search grid. No individual matching the given description was located and no further reports of missing people were filed. All units were released and command was terminated. 5/11/13 Personnel conducting watercraft training at the City Marina were advised of three overdue boaters by a family member. Personnel launched one additional watercraft to search the area near Capers Island. After a short search, the overdue boaters were found at a nearby boat slip. They did not require any assistance and all units returned to training. 5/12/13 Personnel responded to Awendaw Fire Department Station No. 1 for a standby. Engine 1001 responded and stood by in station while crews from Awendaw extinguished a structure fire. Engine 1001 was requested to the scene to provided additional lighting. 5/17/13 Personnel responded to Awendaw Fire Department Station No. 1 for a standby. Engine 1001 responded and stood by in station while crews from Awendaw extinguished a structure fire. 5/28/13 Personnel responded to assist the Sullivan's Island Fire Department with a water mission. Isle of Palms personnel launched a watercraft from the beach at 3rd Avenue and began searching the ocean waters going toward Sullivan's Island. A victim was spotted in the water by the U.S. Coast Guard helicopter assisting in the search and personnel proceeded to the location. The victim was loaded on to the rescue sled of Boat 10 Alpha

and brought to the shore where the patient was transferred into the

Battalion Chief's vehicle. Patient care was then transferred to Charleston County EMS for transport. All watercraft were then returned to service.
