The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of August, 2013.

August 02: Friday

Motor Vehicle Theft: The complainant reported that two white male subjects stole a golf cart from the Boardwalk at Grand Pavilion. Surveillance video was obtained from resort security for follow-up investigation. On 08/16/13, IOPPD received information that the Mount Pleasant Police Department had located the stolen golf cart in a wooded area, in their jurisdiction. The golf cart was returned to the owner, after being processed for evidence. A latent print was lifted from the cart.

August 03: Saturday

Simple Assault: Fairway Oaks Lane. The victim reported that while she and her family were visiting from Florida, her fiancée's daughter physically assaulted her in her facial region, after an on-going verbal altercation. The victim fled the scene and returned to her residence in Florida.

Traffic Offense: 5700 block of Palm Boulevard. Officers were dispatched to the 5700 block of Palm Boulevard in reference to a reckless driver that had possibly caused damage to the gate at the dead end of Palm Boulevard, near Gate 2 of Wild Dunes. The suspect vehicle was located, and a traffic stop was conducted. The driver was charged accordingly.

Domestic Dispute: 5800 block of Palmetto Drive. Officers responded to a domestic dispute, wherein, information was obtained indicating a verbal altercation occurred between a newly wedded couple. There were no indications or visible manifestations that a physical assault occurred.

August 04: Sunday

Traffic Offense: 1100 block of Ocean Boulevard. An Officer conducting patrol in the front beach area, observed a vehicle being operated in an erratic manner. A traffic stop was conducted and the driver was charged accordingly.

Disorderly Conduct: 700 block of Ocean Boulevard. Officers responded to the area in reference to an intoxicated female subject walking along Ocean Boulevard. Officers made contact with the subject, who was in fact intoxicated. During the roadside investigation, the female subject used profanity in a loud manner, which was heard by individuals in the surrounding area. The subject was placed under arrest and charged with Disorderly Conduct.

Alcohol Violation: Ocean Boulevard at 10th Avenue. An Officer conducting patrol in the area observed a subject in possession of, and consuming an alcoholic beverage while walking along Ocean Boulevard. The subject was charged accordingly.

August 06: Tuesday

Traffic Offense: 3000 block of Waterway Boulevard. An Officer conducting patrol on Waterway Boulevard observed a vehicle that appeared to be traveling at a higher rate of speed than that posted. After confirming the violation, the Officer conducted a traffic stop. During the roadside investigation, it was determined that the registration for the vehicle had expired. The subject was charged accordingly.

August 09: Friday

Petit Larceny: 1100 block of Ocean Boulevard. The victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole her handbag from inside the public restrooms.

August 11: Sunday

Grand Larceny: 100 block of Ocean Boulevard. The victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole her diamond ring from the master bathroom. Property is an owner rental.

Petit Larceny: 1400 block of the Beach. A victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole an iPhone, cash, and credit cards, which was left unsecured on the beach.

Petit Larceny: 1400 block of the Beach. The victim reported that unknown subjects(s) stole her cell phone, iPod, and jewelry, which was left unsecured on the beach.

Traffic Offense/Driving Under Suspension (DUS): 3700 block of Palm Boulevard. An Officer conducting patrol in the area observed a vehicle with an equipment violation. After conducting a traffic stop on the vehicle, it was learned that the operator's driver's license was suspended. The subject was placed under arrest and charged with DUS.

August 12: Monday

Petit Larceny: 11th Avenue and Oak Harbor Boulevard. The victim reported that unknown subject(s) stole a blower from his utility trailer.

Traffic Offense/Driving Under Suspension (DUS): Palm Boulevard at 41st Avenue. An Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for an equipment violation. During the roadside investigation, it was determined that the operator's driver's license was suspended. The subject was placed under arrest and charged with DUS.

Open Container: 14th Avenue. An Officer patrolling the area of County Park observed a subject operating a low-speed vehicle, in possession and consuming an alcoholic beverage. The subject was charged accordingly.

Simple Possession of Marijuana: Palm Boulevard at 41st Avenue. An Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for a speeding violation. During the roadside interview, the Officer detected a strong smell of an alcoholic beverage emitting from within the vehicle. Consequently, the driver was requested to step out of the vehicle, thereafter a search of the vehicle was conducted. The search produced paraphernalia, commonly used for smoking marijuana, and a quantity of a green, plantlike material (GPM) identified as marijuana. The subject was placed under arrest and charged with Speeding, Simple Possession of Marijuana, and Unlawful Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

August 15: Thursday

Theft From A Motor Vehicle: 2200 block of Palm Boulevard. The victim reported that unknown subject(s) stole three bags of clothing from his unsecured vehicle.

Petit Larceny: 41st Avenue. The victim reported that unknown subjects(s) entered her unsecured pursue, while she was working and stole two credit cards.

Petit Larceny: Twin Oaks Lane. The victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole his wooden step ladder.

During the roadside investigation, it was determined that the subject had an outstanding warrant with the Charleston County Sheriff's Office (CCSO). The subject was detained and turned over to a CCSO Deputy.

Simple Possession of Marijuana/Liquor Law Violation: 1500 block of Palm Boulevard. Officers responded to a local business in reference to two, under-aged subjects attempting to purchase alcohol with a fake ID. Officers located and detained the subjects. A search of their vehicle produced several pieces of drug paraphernalia and a quantity of marijuana. The subjects were arrested and charged accordingly.

Burglary: 1200 block of Palm Boulevard. The victim reported that unknown subjects took and carried away one of his surfboards, which had been stored under a building with the underneath portion secured with lattice. The subjects forcibly removed the lattice and took a surfboard.
