The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of January, 2013.

(January 3: Thursday)

Burglary: Pelican Reach. A victim reported that unknown subject(s) forced open a secured door in her garage area. The victim, being a long-term renter, was not able to advise whether or not anything had been stolen from within.

(January 5: Tuesday)

Petit Larceny: Sandcrab Court. The victim reported that unknown subjects stole two (2) lawnmowers and a pole trimmer from her residence.

(January 07: Monday)

Harassing Phone Calls: 2200 Block of Waterway Boulevard. A victim advised that an ex-boyfriend has been texting and calling her, threatening to send lewd pictures of her to friends and family if she did not return his communication.


