Call Summary Report
January 2014

- 1/1/14 Personnel responded to a structure fire on Seagrass Lane. Prior to arrival units were advised the fire had been extinguished by the homeowner. Upon arrival, the crew met with the homeowner who explained a candle had ignited the wall covering, but they were able to put the fire out. A quick investigation showed charring on the floor and wall. The area was examined for extension, none was found. All units returned to service.
- 1/5/14 Personnel responded to a report of a lost boater in the Intracoastal Waterway. Boat 1020 was launched and proceeded to search the areas of Dewees Inlet, Long Creek, and the Intracoastal Waterway up to Bulls Bay without finding anything. After searching along the waterway and the front beach area, command was advised that the lost boater had run aground on a sandbar, but was now at home and safe. All units returned to service.
- 1/24/14 Personnel responded to a structure fire on Hidden Green Lane. Upon arrival crews found fire showing from the chimney of the two-story residence. Command was established and hose lines were pulled to begin extinguishment. While the fire was being contained from the outside, crews proceeded to the interior to check for extension. Within a short time the fire was controlled and all units began the overhaul process. Ventilation and salvage was conducted, and all fire was extinguished. All units returned to service.
- 1/27/14 Personnel responded to a structure fire on Carolina Boulevard. Upon arrival crews found a tree on the near side of the structure on fire with fire extending in to the attic due to the wind conditions. An attack line was pulled to the side of the residence. After the visible fire was knocked down, crews advanced in to the residence to check for extension in to the attic. It was determined all fire had been extinguished, and crews began salvage and overhaul procedures. All units returned to service.

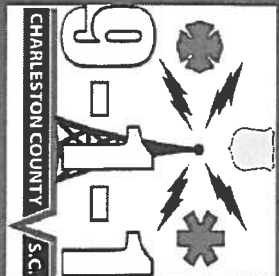

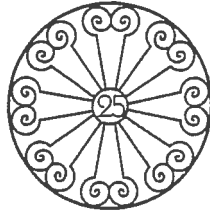
