Call Summary
July 2014

- 7/1/14 Personnel responded to report of two kayakers in distress between the Isle of Palms and Bull's Bay. A jet ski was launched and searched the area from the Isle of Palms Marina to Hamlin Sound before the incident commander was advised that personnel from the Charleston County Rescue Squad had located the victims. Assistance was provided by Charleston County Rescue and all Isle of Palms personnel returned to the marina. All units were placed back in service.
- Personnel assisted law enforcement with a missing person incident. The fire department provided transportation along the beach from 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 44<sup>th</sup> Avenue for a father searching for his son. After the completion of the search, law enforcement took control of the matter. All units were placed back in service.
- 7/3/14 Personnel responded to a report of a shark bite. Upon arrival personnel found the victim seated in the back of a pickup truck with an obvious bite to their forearm. The patient was treated and care was turned over the Charleston County EMS for transport to a local hospital.
- 7/4/14 Personnel responded to a possible commercial structure fire at a business on Palm Boulevard. Upon arrival there were no signs of smoke or fire present. The store manager advised there was a haze of smoke in the building, but could not locate the source. Crews began to investigate and determined a circulation fan in the walk-in cooler had malfunctioned. The power to unit was secured and the store manager contacted a repair technician. All units returned to service.
- 7/4/14 Personnel responded with law enforcement to the Isle of Palms Marina for a report of a suspicious package. Upon arrival fire department units staged a safe distance away while waiting for the Charleston County Sheriff's Office Bomb Squad to arrive and assess the package found on a dock light. While staged, a person walked up to the scene and said the package in question belonged to them. The person was taken to the law enforcement officials in charge and eventually with the assistance of the bomb squad, the package was opened and found to be non-hazardous. All units returned to service.
- 7/14/14 Personnel responded to a report of a jet ski stranded on a sand bar on the beach side behind a condominium complex on Palmetto Drive. Upon arrival personnel observed a jet ski and it's operator on a large sand bar. A jet ski was launched and the crew member made contact with the stranded watercraft. The watercraft was inoperable and due to impending bad weather the decision was made to tow the unit back to shore. Once on shore the unit was secured and all fire department units returned to service.

Personnel responded to a report of a boat in distress in the Intracoastal Waterway near Capers Island. Boat 1020 was launched and while enroute to the area came upon the boat and its owner. The boat had been secured to a private dock, but was inoperable. The boat owner got on Boat 1020 and all parties proceeded to Capers Island where the remainder of the family had been stranded. Once there, the family boarded Boat 1020 and were returned to the Isle of Palms Marina.


