Call Summary

September 2014

- 9/1/14 Personnel responded to the ocean in the area of Mariner's Walk for a report of swimmers stranded on a sand bar. Upon arrival crews confirmed three people were on the sand bar, but not in any distress. They reported that a shark had been circling the sand bar and they could not get back to shore. Jet Ski 1002 was launched and the individuals were returned to shore. No further assistance was required and all units returned to service.
- 9/6/14 Personnel responded to Breach Inlet for a report of two swimmers in distress. Upon arrival the crew confirmed there were two swimmers about 200 yards from shore that needed assistance. Jet Ski 1001 was launched and quickly met up with the first swimmer. The swimmer was given a personal flotation device and told to standby while the second swimmer who was further out was recovered. After the second swimmer was onboard Jet Ski 1001 they returned and picked up the first swimmer. All parties were brought back to shore and required no further attention. All units returned to service.
- 9/10/14 Personnel responded in Boat 1020 to Capers Island with Charleston County EMS for an individual that suffered a traumatic injury. Upon arrival at the scene it was determined the patient's injuries required air transport. Fire department personnel assisted with packaging and loading of the patient, and transported the patient and medic crew to Dewees Island's helicopter landing area. A medical helicopter met the personnel there and patient care was transferred. The patient's husband was brought back to the Isle of Palms Marina so he could continue on to the hospital. All units returned to service.
- 9/19/14 Personnel responded to the golf course in the area of Commons Court for a golf cart fire. Prior to the fire department's arrival it was determined the fire was out. The crew arrived and confirmed the fire was out, disconnected the battery, and advised the owner to have it looked at by an authorized repair facility. All units returned to service.

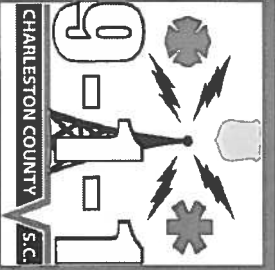
