The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of January, 2014.

# January 2: Thursday

<u>Vandalism</u>: 27th Avenue. The victim reported that a possible known suspect(s) damaged a nativity scene in his front yard.

# January 3: Friday

<u>Traffic Arrest/Driving Under The Influence</u>: 2300 block of Palm Boulevard. An Officer conducting patrol in the area of Palm Boulevard and 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue observed a vehicle being operated in a careless manner. After conducting a traffic stop and completing a roadside investigation, the operator of the vehicle was placed under arrest for DUI, Open Container and Minor in Possession of Beer.

<u>Traffic Arrest</u>: 29<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Cameron Boulevard. An Officer conducting patrol of the area observed a vehicle displaying a suspended license plate. After conducting a traffic stop and completing the roadside investigation, the operator was placed under arrest for not having a S. C. Driver's License, Operating Uninsured Vehicle and Failure to Surrender Suspended License Plate.

#### January 4: Saturday

<u>Simple Assault</u>: 100 block of Palm Boulevard. The victim reported that a known suspect assaulted him by pushing him in the face, causing him to fall to the ground.

<u>Disorderly Conduct</u>: J. C. Long Boulevard. An Officer was dispatched to a local establishment in reference to an intoxicated female. Upon arrival, the Officer located the subject who was in fact intoxicated and uncooperative. The subject was placed under arrest and charged accordingly.

<u>Criminal Domestic Violence</u>: 600 block of Ocean Boulevard. Officers were dispatched to the incident location in reference to a physical domestic disturbance. The Officers met with the female victim who reported that her intoxicated boyfriend pushed her and shattered a glass door; thereafter, fled the scene on foot. Officers were able to located the male subject hiding behind some bushes in the backyard of the residence. The subject was placed under arrest and charged with Criminal Domestic Violence.

<u>Simple Assault</u>: 100 block of Palm Boulevard. Two employees of a local establishment were engaged in a verbal dispute when one of the subjects escalated the situation by physically assaulting the other. The aggressor was placed under arrest and charged with Simple Assault.

# January 7: Tuesday

<u>Warrant Arrest</u>: 1100 block of Ocean Boulevard. An Officer conducting patrol of the front beach area observed a suspicious vehicle. While conducting a roadside interview with the two occupants, it was learned that one of the subjects had an outstanding warrant out of the Coweta (Georgia) County Sheriff's Office. The subject was detained and transported to the Al Cannon Detention Facility to await extradition.

<u>Traffic Arrest</u>: 2100 block of Palm Boulevard. An Officer conducting patrol in the area of Palm Boulevard and 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue observed a vehicle with equipment violations. After conducting a traffic stop and completing a roadside investigation, the operator was charged with No Driver's License.

<u>Narcotics Violation</u>: 100 block of Palm Boulevard. An Officer conducting patrol in the area of Breach Inlet observed a vehicle with a defective tag light. After conducting a traffic stop and while conducting a roadside investigation, the Officer detected the odor of marijuana emitting from within the vehicle. It was determined that the two occupants had just smoked marijuana a short time prior to the traffic stop, and still had in their possession a quantity of marijuana and a grinder. Both the operator and passenger of the vehicle were placed under arrest and charged.

# January 8: Wednesday

<u>Traffic Arrest/Driving Under Suspension</u>: 2200 block of Palm Boulevard. An Officer conducting patrol in the area of Palm Boulevard and 22nd Avenue observed a vehicle with equipment violations. After conducting a traffic stop and completing a roadside investigation, the operator was charged with Driving Under Suspension.

# January 10: Friday

<u>Vandalism</u>: 34th Avenue. The victim reported that a possible known suspect damaged his vehicle by marking the inside of the car with permanent marker.

#### January 11: Saturday

<u>Traffic Arrest/Driving Under Suspension</u>: 2300 block of Cameron Boulevard. An Officer conducting patrol in the area of Cameron Boulevard and 23rd Avenue observed the operator of a vehicle disregard the stop sign at the intersection. After conducting a traffic stop and completing a roadside investigation, the operator was charged with Driving Under Suspension, No Insurance, Lend/Borrow/Steal License Plate and Disregarding a Stop Sign.

<u>Warrant Arrest</u>: IOP Connector. An Officer conducting patrol on the Connector observed a vehicle swerve outside their designated lane of travel. After conducting a traffic stop and during the roadside investigation, it was established that the operator of the vehicle had an outstanding warrant out of the Charleston County Sheriff's Office (CCSO). <u>Traffic Arrest/Driving Under Suspension</u>: 2100 block of Palm Boulevard. An Officer conducting patrol in the area of Palm Boulevard and 21st Avenue observed a vehicle with defective equipment. After conducting a traffic stop and while completing a roadside investigation, it was learned that the operator's driver's license was suspended for failure to pay three (3) traffic fines and that there was an active warrant out of the Orangeburg County Sheriff's Office. The operator was placed under arrest and transported to the Al Cannon Detention Facility to await extradition.

- "Administratively Closed" (Non-criminal incident or investigation suspended). All available leads have been exhausted, but the case has not been brought to a conclusion, and investigative efforts may be resumed if new evidence or leads are discovered at a later date.
