The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of June 2014.

Sunday, June 1, 2014

Petit Larceny – Beach / 21st Avenue

Complainant reported that while surfing he had left a bag with his belongings on the beach. Upon his return, an unknown person(s) had taken his bag. 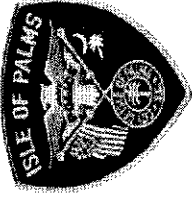
