The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of September.

## Wednesday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>

### Burglary – 700 Block Ocean Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown person(s) stole a kite board and kite boarding accessories from his garage area under the residence. The approximate value of the items stolen is \$5,420. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

## Friday, September 4<sup>th</sup>

### Disorderly Conduct – Area of 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue

Officers responded to a report of a fight. Investigation determined that two subjects who were intoxicated began to fight. Officers found one of the subjects unconscious, issued him a citation and he was transported to the hospital for treatment. The other subject was arrested and lodged at the Charleston County Detention Center.

## Sunday, September 6<sup>th</sup>

### Driving Under the Influence – HL Hunley Memorial Bridge

An Officer stopped a vehicle for multiple moving violations. During contact with the driver, it was suspected that he was under the influence. When asked, the driver admitted to drinking 4 or 5 beers during the afternoon. The Officer requested the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and at their conclusion, was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to the Charleston County Detention Center for Datamaster Testing where he refused to submit a breath sample. The subject was lodged.

## Monday, September 7<sup>th</sup>

### Petit Larceny – 1100 Block Ocean Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown person(s) stole her iPad from the room she was occupying. The approximate value of the item is \$440. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

## **Tuesday, September 8<sup>th</sup>**

### **Warrant Arrest – Palm Boulevard / 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue**

An Officer got out with a suspicious vehicle and persons and after checking their information, discovered that one of the subjects had an active arrest warrant with Charleston County Sheriff's Office for a family court violation. The warrant was confirmed; the subject was arrested and transferred to the custody of the Charleston County Sheriff's Office.

### **Credit Card Fraud – JC Long Boulevard**

A local establishment reported that they discovered an employee who was stealing money from patron's credit cards. The complainant also made contact with the victims whose credit cards had been charged. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

## **Wednesday, September 9<sup>th</sup>**

### **Public Intoxication – 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue / Waterway Boulevard**

An Officer stopped a subject driving a moped in an erratic manner and stopped him. It was determined that the operator of the moped was intoxicated, was arrested and lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

### **Agency Assist – Sullivan's Island Police Dept. – Breach Inlet Area**

Agencies received information regarding a possible suicidal subject, whom Sullivan's Island Police located parked on their side of Breach Inlet. Due to the subject having a weapon, Isle of Palms Police Officers assisted by stopping all traffic in the area until the situation could be resolved. The Officers were able to make contact with the subject and take him into Emergency Protective Custody.

## **Saturday, September 12<sup>th</sup>**

### **Vandalism – Ocean Point**

A victim reported that unknown person(s) damaged her water urn / fountain which was located near the back stairs at the rear of the residence. The approximate value of the item is \$1500. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

## **Monday, September 14<sup>th</sup>**

### **Driving Under the Influence – Palm Boulevard / 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue**

An Officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 46 MPH in a posted 35 MPH speed zone. Contact with the driver revealed that she was possibly under the influence. When asked, the driver indicated that she had consumed two mixed drinks. The Officer then requested that the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and at the conclusion was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to IOPPSB for Datamaster testing where she refused to submit a breath sample. The driver was lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

### **Petit Larceny – Dock near 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue / Waterway Boulevard**

A victim reported that an unknown person(s) stole her stand up paddleboard and paddle. The approximate value of the items is \$1150. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

### **Wednesday, September 16<sup>th</sup>**

#### **Grand Larceny** – 5800 Block Palmetto Boulevard

A victim reported that an unknown person(s) stole her ring from inside the residence. The approximate value of the item is \$8970. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

### **Friday, September 18<sup>th</sup>**

#### **Identity Fraud** – Ocean Point

A victim reported that unknown person(s) fraudulently used his identity to attempt a withdrawal from his account amounting to \$4500. Additionally, they had gained access to the victim's cell phone and had it forwarded to a different number. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

### **Saturday, September 19<sup>th</sup>**

#### **Disorderly Conduct** – 900 Block Ocean Boulevard

Officers responded to a report of a male subject who ran from a local establishment into a residence. Officers located the subject, who had entered into a house where he was not staying. Further investigation revealed that the subject was intoxicated and could not provide any information. The subject was arrested and lodged at the Charleston County Detention Center.

#### **Petit Larceny** – Beach Club Villas

A victim reported that an unknown person(s) stole personal items from a locked dresser located inside the residence. The approximate value of the items is \$450. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

### **Sunday, September 20<sup>th</sup>**

#### **Driving Under the Influence** – 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue / Palm Boulevard

An Officer stopped a vehicle for multiple moving violations. Contact with the driver revealed that she was possibly under the influence. When asked, the driver admitted to having two glasses of wine. The Officer then requested the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety tests and at their conclusion was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to IOPPSB for Datamaster testing where she refused to provide a breath sample. Additionally, the Officer located marijuana and drug paraphernalia in the driver's property. The driver was lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

#### **Burglary** – 500 Block Ocean Boulevard

A victim reported that an unknown person(s) stole prescription medications from inside the residence. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

#### **Driving Under the Influence** – 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue / Waterway Boulevard

An Officer stopped a vehicle for multiple moving violations. Contact with the driver revealed that she was possibly under the influence. When asked the driver, admitted to drinking earlier in the day. The Officer requested the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety tests and at their conclusion was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to IOPPSB for Datamaster testing where she refused to provide a breath sample. The driver was lodged at the Charleston County Detention Center.

**Friday, September 25<sup>th</sup>**

**Petit Larceny – 25<sup>th</sup> Avenue / Beach Access Path**

A victim reported that an unknown person(s) stole her bicycle. The approximate value of the item is \$200. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

**Saturday, September 26<sup>th</sup>**

**Driving Under the Influence – 41<sup>st</sup> Avenue**

An Officer responded to a report of a collision between two vehicles and observed that one of the drivers was possibly under the influence. When asked, the driver indicated that he only had two beers. The Officer then requested the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety tests and at the conclusion, was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to the IOPPSB for Datamaster testing where he provided a breath sample with a BAC of .19%. The driver was lodged at the Charleston County Detention Center.

**Monday, September 28<sup>th</sup>**

**Theft from Motor Vehicle – 1100 Block Ocean Boulevard**

A victim reported that an unknown person(s) entered into his unlocked vehicle and stole a handgun and other accessories. The approximate value of the items stolen is \$1522. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

**Petit Larceny – 46<sup>th</sup> Avenue**

A victim reported that an unknown person(s) stole prescription medications from her residence. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

**Wednesday, September 30<sup>th</sup>**

**Fraud – 1100 Block Ocean Boulevard**

A victim reported that an unknown person(s) made unauthorized charges to his credit card. The approximate amount charged is \$490. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

**Driving Under the Influence – IOP Connector**

An Officer stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. Contact with the driver revealed that he was possibly under the influence. When asked, the driver indicated that he drank two beers earlier. The Officer requested that the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety tests, at their conclusion was arrested. The driver was transported to IOPPSB for Datamaster testing, where he refused to submit a breath sample. The driver was charged with DUI 3<sup>rd</sup> offense, DUS 3<sup>rd</sup> offense, and Habitual Offender. The driver was lodged at Charleston County Detention Center.

### **Community Service Mentions**

During the month of September 2015, Officers issued four (4) "You Could Have Been a Victim of a Crime" notices and forty-five (45) Property Security Check notices.

Officers continued their efforts with conducting enforcement on the beach in an effort to address citizen concerns of littering, alcohol on the beach and glass on the beach. As a result, ten (10) citations were issued for alcohol on the beach.

### **Car Seat Installation / Inspection**

During the month of September 2015, Officers certified as Child Passenger Seat (CPS) Technicians assisted three (3) citizens with the proper installation of child safety seats in their vehicle.

### **Personnel Recognition**

Command Staff recognizes the Animal Control Officers for their efforts in enforcing ordinances and at the same time building positive relationships with our citizens. In addition to their daily duties, ACO Enourato and ACO Fitzpatrick can be depended upon to complete any task needed. They assist with the maintenance of equipment and facilities. These two employees do an outstanding job, they are courteous and professional in their demeanor and the Department appreciates their efforts.
