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## **Isle of Palms Fire Department**

### **Call Summary Report**

*January 2016*

- 1/6/16 Personnel responded to a request for mutual aid by the Awendaw Fire Department for a structure fire on Rifle Range Road. Upon arrival the crew was staged as the rapid intervention team. After the fire was extinguished, the crew reassigned to salvage and overhaul duties. The crew also assisted with clean up at the scene before being released and returning to the island.
- 1/17/16 Personnel responded to a report of six people and dog stranded on the north end of Capers Island. Boat 1020 was launched and proceeded to the area. The group had become stranded due to a drastic change in the weather while they were camping. Vessels from the U.S. Coast Guard, North Charleston Fire Department, and the Charleston County Sheriff's Office also responded to assist. All of the stranded campers and their dog were rescued, along with their kayaks and camping gear. All people and possessions were returned to Garris Boat Landing – their launching point – without further incident and all units returned to service.


