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Isle of Palms Fire Department Call Summary April 2017

- 4/3/2017 Personnel responded to a report of a house that had been struck by lightning on Back Bay Drive. Upon arrival the crew found that the house had been struck on the side. There was no active burning found, but the home's electrical system had been damaged. One breaker was placed in the off position at the electrical box. It was explained to the home owner not to turn the breaker back on until the issue is fixed by a qualified repair
- 4/8/17 Personnel responded to a report of an outside fire at a condominium unit on Ocean Boulevard. Upon arrival the crew was told that there was a small fire in the pine straw located at the base of the support columns for the building. The fire had already been extinguished via fire extinguisher by one of the residents of the condominium units.

- 4/13/17 Personnel responded to a report of a dog trapped on a small island in the Intercoastal Waterway near the connector bridge. Due to the location of the dog, Charleston County Rescue was called to assist with an airboat to rescue dog.
- 4/14/17 Personnel responded to a report of a missing child on the beach behind Coconut Joe's. Personnel began the search on land with the information that was provided from dispatch. After numerous sweeps of the beach, information was relayed to responders that the child had last been seen in the water. Command launched marine units and called for more resources from the United States Coast guard and others from around the county. Dispatch stated that they received a call from a resident that said she had found a young boy that had been alone on the beach and that he was at her home on Ocean Boulevard. Fire crews confirmed that this was the missing child and reunited him with his father.
- 4/20/17 Personnel responded to Ensign Court for a report of an outside fire. Upon arrival, crews found an outside fire on Goat Island that had gotten out of control. Boat 1020 was launched to better evaluate the situation and extinguish the fire. Sullivan's Island Fire Department, Charleston Fire Department, and North Charleston Fire Department were requested for assistance. Isle of Palms fire crews were met by Sullivan's Island Fire Department personnel and began firefighting operations. A bystander assisted with a trackhoe. Fire personnel were able to quickly get the fire under control. All other responding crews were cancelled.
- 4/24/2017 Personnel responded to three individuals who were stranded on Caper's Island. The three individuals were in an inflatable raft that had become deflated. Upon arrival the three individuals were found sitting on an oyster bed. Fire crews assisted them onto Boat 1020 and returned them to the Isle of Palms Marina.

Isle of Palms Fire Department Call Summary April 2017

4/25/17 Personnel assisted a resident whose boat was taking on water at a dock on Waterway Island. It was found that the rear bildge pump had stopped working. The crew pumped out the stern of the boat and offered advice on how to correct the problem to avoid further issues.
