Call Summary

June 2017

- 6/3/17 Personnel responded to the Marina on 41st Avenue in regards to a vehicle accident. Crews found the patient sitting in the parking lot a few feet from a moped. The patient stated that she had fallen twice and hit her head both times. The patient had some swelling and minor bleeding. Bleeding was controlled and ice packs were applied to the patient's head where she stated it hurt. Charleston County EMS assumed patient care and the patient was transported to the hospital. All responding units returned back to service.
- 6/5/17 Personnel responded along with Sullivan's Island Fire Department for a water rescue at Breach Inlet. Jet Ski 1001 was launched to assist with the rescue. One swimmer was rescued and brought ashore. There was no need for medical assistance following the rescue. All responding units returned back to service.
- 6/8/17 Personnel responded to a possible gas leak at 41st Avenue. While investigating, fire crews noticed a strong odor of gas in the area of the propane tank outside of the residence. Personnel secured the tank at the valve. The house was also inspected and no smell of gas was detected. The occupants of the home were advised to have a qualified person inspect the gas service and make any necessary repairs prior to re-establishing the service. All responding units returned back to service.
- 6/10/17 Personnel responded to a possible gas leak at the 1500 block of Palm Boulevard. Upon arrival, dispatch advised responding crews that there was a propane tank leak. Fire crews found the leaking propane tank outside next to the Harris Teeter grocery store. Fire crews were able to secure the tank and stop the leak. All responding units returned back to service.
- 6/15/17 Personnel responded to a report of a dog that had been chasing ducks in the water by Little Goat island across from Hamlin Creek. Fire crews launched a jet ski and responded to the area where the dog was last seen. While searching, personnel called the dog's name which resulted in the dog coming to the crew from the island. Personnel were able to pick up the dog and return him to his owner. All responding units returned back to service.
- 6/17/17 Personnel responded to a report of a suspicious package located in front of a real estate office at the 1400 block of Palm Boulevard. Fire crews staged at Fire Station No. 1 while Isle of Palms Police personnel investigated the package. All crews were cleared from the call when it was found that the package was safe.
