Call Summary

March 2017

- 3/10/17 Personnel responded to a report of an automobile that struck a house in the area of Palm Boulevard and 21st Avenue. Upon arrival the crew found that the vehicle had driven through a fence and into the parking area of the house. The driver was in full arrest and CPR was performed including the use of the Automated External Defibrillator. On scene providers regained a pulse prior to the patient being loaded into the ambulance.
- 3/12/17 Personnel responded to a report of an outside fire on Carolina Boulevard. Upon arrival crews found a small propane grill on fire due to grease build up. The fire was extinguished with a dry chemical fire extinguisher.
- 3/17/17 Personnel responded to a report of a person trapped in a stalled elevator. Crews were able to open the doors on the fourth floor and assisted the individual from the elevator. Crews secured power to the elevator. Property management was advised to make necessary repairs to the elevator system.
- 3/22/17 Personnel responded to a report of a medical emergency. Upon arrival the crew found a patient with swelling of the eyes and difficulty breathing resulting from obvious signs of an allergic reaction. The crew administered one adult dose of Epinephrine via an auto-injector. The patient was then put on oxygen and monitored until patient care was transferred to Charleston County Emergency Medical Services.

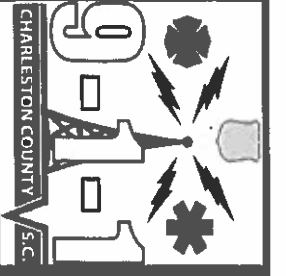
