**Call Summary**  
*May 2017*

- 5/3/2017 Personnel responded to a report of a person in distress in Breach Inlet swimming from Sullivan's Island to Isle of Palms. Personnel responded to the bridge over Breach Inlet to get a visual on the subject. Sullivan's Island Fire Department had multiple assets on scene staging on their side of bridge. The subject swam to the Isle of Palms side of the inlet near the parking lot at Palm Boulevard and Charleston. The Swimmer was taken to speak with Isle of Palms Police officers regarding swimming in Breach Inlet. All units returned to service.
- 5/8/2017 Personnel responded to a report of an attempted suicide on Dunes Boulevard. Crews found a female that had cut her wrists. A patient assessment was performed and it was found that all the bleeding on the patient's wrists had stopped, but cut marks were present. No bandaging was necessary. Charleston County EMS arrived and patient care was transferred. All units returned to service.
- 5/9/2017 Personnel responded to a report of a child locked in a vehicle. Responding crews were able to make access into the vehicle and free the child. No medical assistance was needed. All units returned to service.
- 5/15/2017 Personnel responded to a report of a cardiac arrest at the Charleston County Park Office. Crews found one individual in cardiac arrest. CPR was performed and the Automated External Defibrillator was used. Charleston County EMS arrived on scene and patient care was transferred. Two fire personnel assisted EMS with transport (one driving the ambulance, and the other assisting with patient care). The patient did regain a pulse. Fire personnel were brought back to the Island once the patient was received by the hospital. All units returned to service.
- 5/15/2017 Personnel responded to a report of a fuel spill in the parking lot of the Marina on 41<sup>st</sup> Avenue. The complainant stated that the fueling brake in the pump handle did not engage and overfilled her gas tank. A majority of the fuel had absorbed into the concrete near the fuel pumps. The remainder of fuel left on the ground was estimated to be less than a gallon. Personnel used oil dry to soak up the remainder of the fuel. The driver was concerned about driving the vehicle as well as the fuel damaging the paint. Personnel spoke with a technician from the Toyota dealership just to assure the driver that she could drive her vehicle with no worries. Fire Crews also had the driver come to the fire station, where fire crews washed the left rear section of the vehicle where the fuel had gotten on the paint. All units returned to service.

### Call Summary

- 5/16/2017 Personnel responded to a report of a smell of gas on Carolina Boulevard. Initially crews did not smell anything until they went to the back of the residence and learned that there was a loose adapter on the main gas line of a cooking grill. Personnel secured the gas tank and informed the occupants of the residence not to use the grill until all necessary repairs had been made. All units returned to service.
- 5/20/2017 Personnel responded to a report of a drowning on the beach at 56<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Crews found two individuals who had swam back and were sitting on the beach. Patient assessments were performed on both individuals and patient care was transferred to Charleston County EMS. All units returned to service.
- 5/22/2017 Personnel responded to Sullivan's Island to assist with a structure fire. An Isle of Palms Fire Department crew assisted with an interior fire attack, salvage and overhaul, as well as clean-up operations once the incident was stabilized. All units returned to service.
- 5/24/2017 Personnel responded to a report of a watercraft in distress in the Intracoastal Waterway near Waterway Island. Crews launched a jet-ski in order to make contact with a sailboat that had run aground. The occupant of the vessel stated that he did not need any assistance. After gathering information, fire crews learned that the occupant of the sailboat did not have any way to communicate an emergency need. Coast Guard was notified. Crews attempted to convince the occupant of the vessel to return with them due to expected storms, but were unable to convince the individual to leave the boat. All units returned to service.

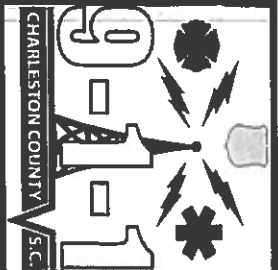
