## Isle of Palms Fire Department

### Call Summary

September 2018

- 9/2/2018 Fire crews responded to a report of a gas leak on Palm Boulevard. Upon arrival, fire department personnel investigated the scene using gas meters to find the source of the leak. It was found that the regulator at the storage tank was almost empty and was off-gassing. The storage tank was secured and the property owner was notified of the issue. All crews cleared from the scene and returned back to service.
- 9/6/2018 Fire crews responded to a report of a structure fire on Waterway Boulevard. Upon arrival, fire department personnel were informed that the homeowner spilled some grease inside the oven while cooking which ignited a small fire inside of the oven. The homeowner closed the oven and confined the fire. The fire had self-extinguished before the arrival of the fire department. Fire crews checked the area for any fire extension and assisted with ventilating the smoke out of the residence. All fire personnel cleared from the scene and returned back to service.
- 9/18/2018 Fire crews responded to a report of a structure fire on Cameron Boulevard. Upon arrival fire department personnel were informed that there had been a small fire which occurred in the garage while working on a hot water heater system. The fire had already been extinguished prior to arrival of the fire department. Fire crews checked the area for any fire extension or other hazards and found none. All personnel cleared from the scene and returned back to service.
- 9/25/2018 Fire crews responded to a report of a structure fire on Ocean Boulevard. Upon arrival crews found flames coming from one of the power outlets located in the residence's Foyer. The fire was extinguished and the area searched for fire extension and any other additional hazards. No other issues were found. Power to the home was disconnected, and it was explained to the homeowner that they needed to have an electrician fix the issued before restoring power back to the home. All personnel cleared from the scene and returned back to service.

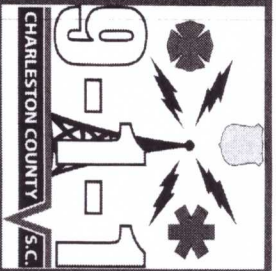

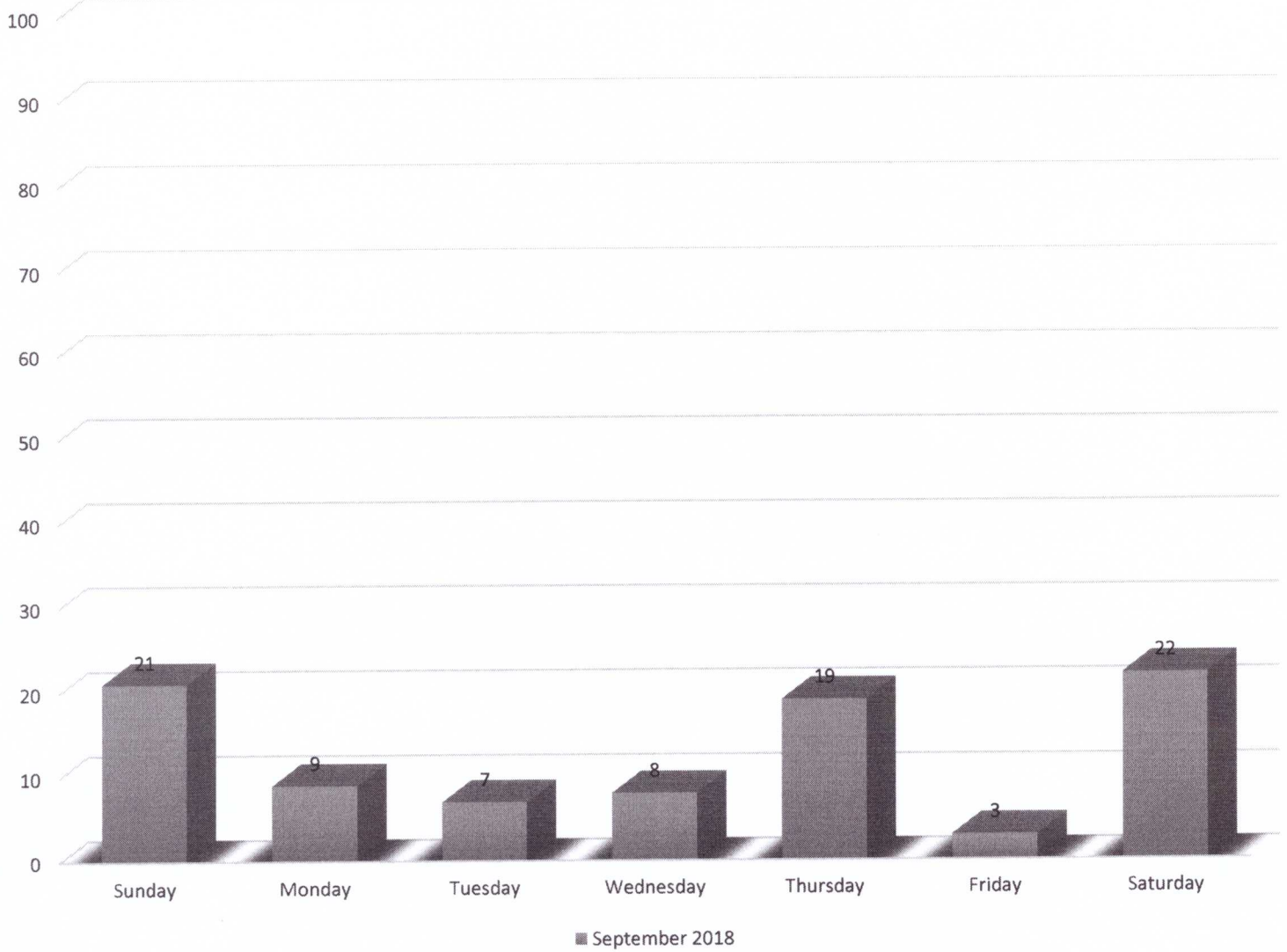

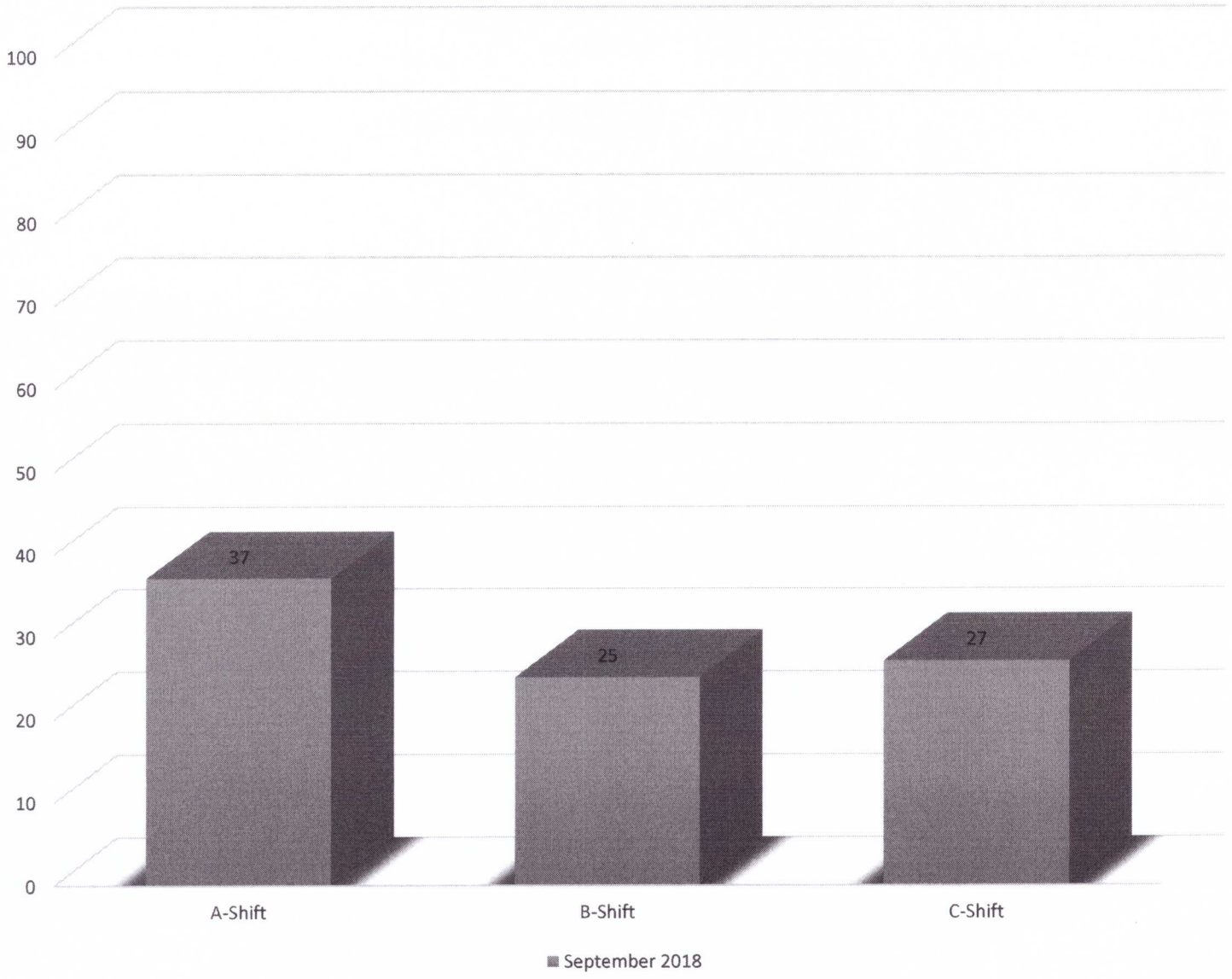

## Calls per Day for September 2018

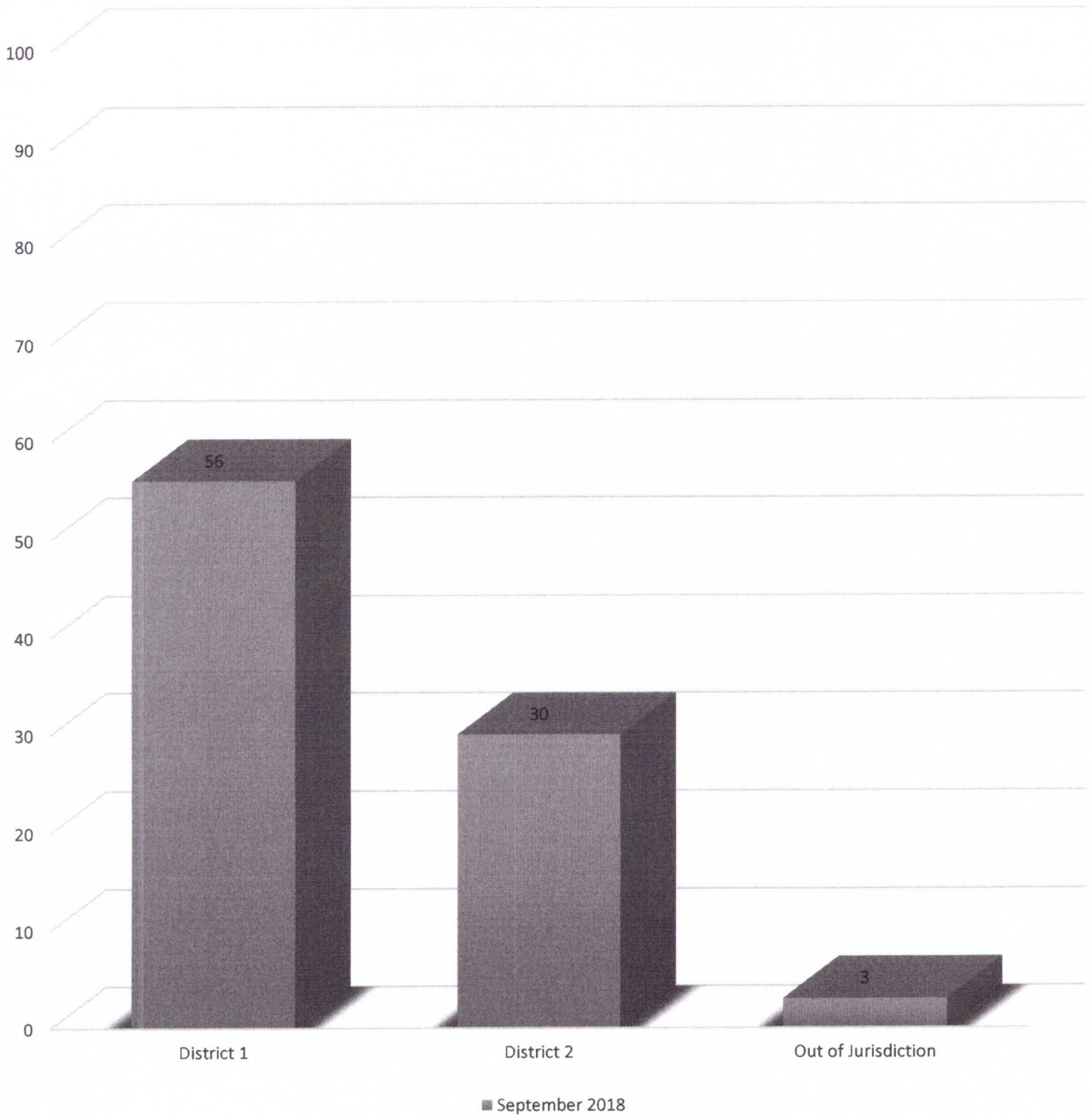




### Calls Per Shift for September 2018
