

12/04/2020	Fire crews responded to Hartnett Boulevard for a report of a water leak. The
	homeowner believed that there was possibly a burst pipe inside of the bathroom
	wall. The main water feed was disconnected at the street, and the hot water
	heater was also secured. The homeowner was advised to have a plumber fix the
	issue before restoring water to the residence. All units cleared from the scene
	and returned back to service.

NOTABLE EVENTS / CALL HIGHLIGHTS

12/21/2020

Fire crews received a phone call from a resident on Waterway Boulevard who reported that a small fire had occurred on his back porch as a result of discarded smoldering fireplace embers. The homeowner stated that the fire had already been extinguished. Fire department personnel responded to the home and found some fire damage to the decking and exterior wall, and minor smoke damage on an interior wall near a window. The occupants had been alerted to the fire from one of the homes smoke detectors. None of the residents were injured. Firefighters checked for any hidden fire extension and found none. All units cleared from the scene and returned back to service.

12/27/2020

Fire crews responded to a structure fire on Seagrass Lane. Upon arrival, personnel found visible smoke and flames coming from the chimney structure of the home. Automatic aid and mutual aid were provided by Sullivan's Island Fire Department and the Town of Mount Pleasant Fire Department. During suppression operations, it was found that the fire had extended into the attic. The fire was confined to the attic and chimney structures of the home and extinguished. Salvage and overhaul operations were conducted to ensure that there were no hidden hot spots or other hazards. All units cleared from the scene and returned back to service.


12/31/2020

Fire Chief Ann Marie Graham retired after 35 years of dedicated service to the City of Isle of Palms, the fire service, and much more.




INCIDENT TYPE

ANNUAL YEAR TO DATE ANALYTIC COMPARISONS






DECEMBER MONTHLY ANALYTIC COMPARISONS





RESIDENCY TYPE ANALYTIC COMPARISONS






TOTAL CALLS IN WILD DUNES






