Isle of Palms Fire Department

Call Summary

June 2016

- 6/3/16 Personnel responded to the front beach around the 600 block of Ocean Boulevard for a report of boat on fire in the ocean. Crews proceeded to the beach to investigate and Boat 1020 was launched. After investigating, crews were able to determine the smoke that was reported was diesel exhaust from a boat's engine. All units returned to service.
- 6/7/16 Personnel responded to a report of two swimmers caught in a rip current in the water around the 4100 block of Palm Boulevard. Upon arrival the crew established visual contact with four individuals on a boogie board. Jet Ski 1002 was launched to check on the individuals. Jet Ski 1002 retrieved all four subjects and returned them to the shore unharmed. All units returned to service.
- 6/7/16 Personnel responded to a report of a canoe that capsized in the ocean behind a condominium on Palmetto Drive. Upon arrival the crew established visual contact with the canoe, seeing two individuals in the canoe and three others hanging on to the canoe. Jet Ski 1002 was launched with two fire department personnel on board. Once they reached the subjects one firefighter got in the water and remained with the subjects as each was retrieved and returned to shore on Jet Ski 1002. Once all five subjects were retrieved, personnel retrieved the canoe. No further action was needed and all units returned to service.
- 6/9/16 Personnel responded to a report of a structure fire at a home on Seagrass Lane. Upon arrival crews observed no signs of smoke or fire from the exterior. The incident commander met with the residents who said they were in the elevator when it stopped between levels. After self-extricating from the elevator the residents observed a light haze of smoke inside the home and called the fire department. Crews quickly identified the source of the smoke as being from the hydraulic pump that operates the elevator. Power to the pump was secured, the area was ventilated, and all areas were checked for active fire. None was found. After ventilation was complete the owners were advised to have the hydraulic pump checked. The building was released to the owners and all units returned to service.
- 6/15/16 Personnel responded to a report of boat sinking at the Dewees Island Marina on 41st Avenue. Upon arrival the crew found a vessel taking on water and began to pump out the water with a portable pump. Once the owner arrived on scene the vessel was turned back over to them. All units returned to service.

6/17/16 Personnel responded to a report of an overturned boat with people in the water in the Intracoastal Waterway. Boat 1020 was launched, but experienced a slow response due to a thunderstorm. After checking on several other vessels along the way, the crew found the initial caller. They were stranded in the marsh, but all occupants of the boat were safe. The boat was secured with an anchor and two adults and three children were transported back to the Isle of Palms Marina on Boat 1020. All units returned to service.


