Call Summary
October 2015

- 10/3/15 Personnel responded to a residence on 55th Avenue to assist two elderly residents with setting up sump pumps in the basement that was flooding due to the heavy rain. One pump was set up in the bathroom and the second pump was set up in the elevator pit. Residents were advised to call if any further assistance was needed.
- 10/3/15 Personnel responded to a residence on 46th Avenue for a reported smell of gasoline in the home. Upon arrival crews confirmed a strong odor of gasoline and determined the source was in the storage area under the home. Several small gas cans tipped over due to the rising water caused by the heavy rains. The cans were placed on high shelves and the resident was directed to open the windows to ventilate the home.
- 10/4/15 Personnel responded to Dewee's Island Marina for a report of a boat sinking. Upon arrival crews found a 21-foot vessel partially submerged and actively taking on water. Crews utilized a dewatering pump to right the vessel. S.C. Department of Natural Resources was notified due to a small amount of fuel that had spilled into the water.
- 10/5/15 Personnel responded to Dewee's Island Marina for a report of a boat sinking. Upon arrival the crew found a vessel taking on water. Both bilge pumps were malfunctioning and the crew determined the best action to take would be removing the boat from the water. Utilizing a spare boat trailer that was on site, the crew removed the boat from the water.
- 10/11/15 Personnel responded to a report of watercraft in distress in Caper's Inlet. The vessel, a 35-foot shrimp boat, had run aground in Caper's Inlet. Jet Ski 1002 was launched and later advised the vessel was actually in the area of Price's Inlet. Jet Ski 1002 arrived on scene and confirmed the vessel was aground, but no one was in distress. The vessel was anchored and awaiting other assistance. Jet Ski 1002 returned to the marina and all units returned to service.


