ORDINANCE 2021-15

AN ORDINANCE TO TEMPORARILY SUSPEND ENFORCEMENT OF TITLE 3, PUBLIC WORKS, CHAPTER 4, ENVIRONMENTALLY ACCEPTABLE PACKAGING AND PRODUCTS, **SECTION 3-4-6(a), PROHIBITED SALES AND USES**, OF THE CITY OF ISLE OF PALMS CODE OF ORDINANCES, FOR BUSINESSES AFFECTED BY GLOBAL SUPPLY CHAIN ISSUES DUE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEMBERS OF THE CITY OF ISLE OF PALMS, SOUTH CAROLINA, IN CITY COUNCIL ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. That enforcement of <u>Section 3-4-6(a)</u>, <u>Prohibited sales and uses of</u> Chapter 4, Environmentally Acceptable Packaging and Products, of Title 3, Public Works, of the City of Isle of Palms Code of Ordinances, is hereby temporarily suspended for a period of <u>six (6)</u> months for businesses affected by global supply chain issues due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

SECTION 2. That should any part of this Ordinance be held invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining parts shall be severable therefrom and shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affect this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon ratification and shall expire on, 2022.
