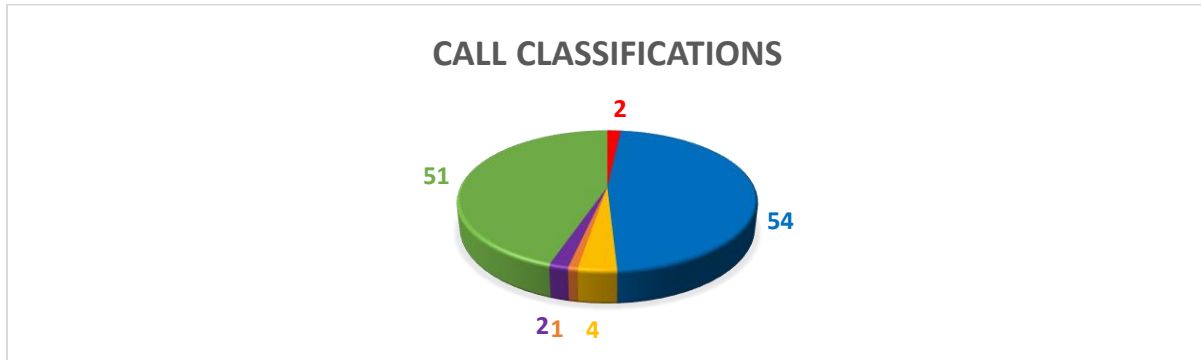


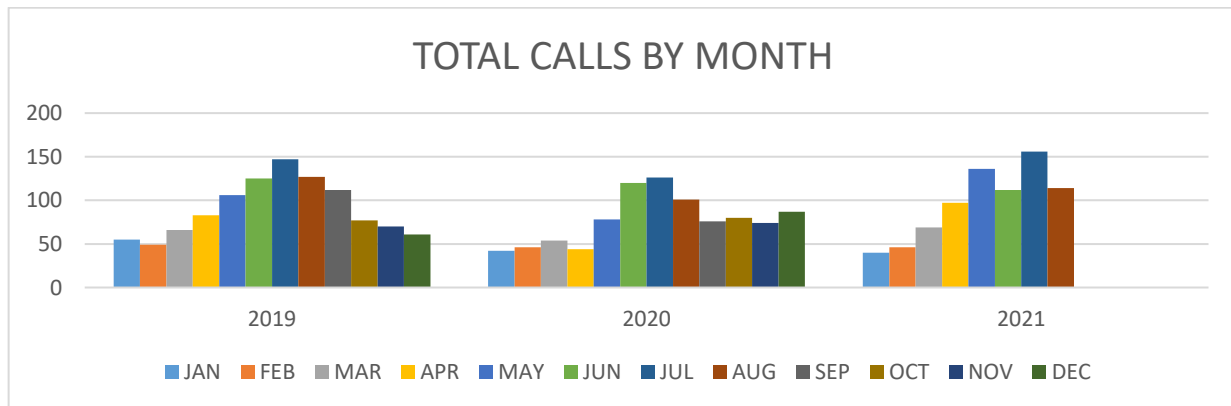

### NOTABLE EVENTS / CALL HIGHLIGHTS

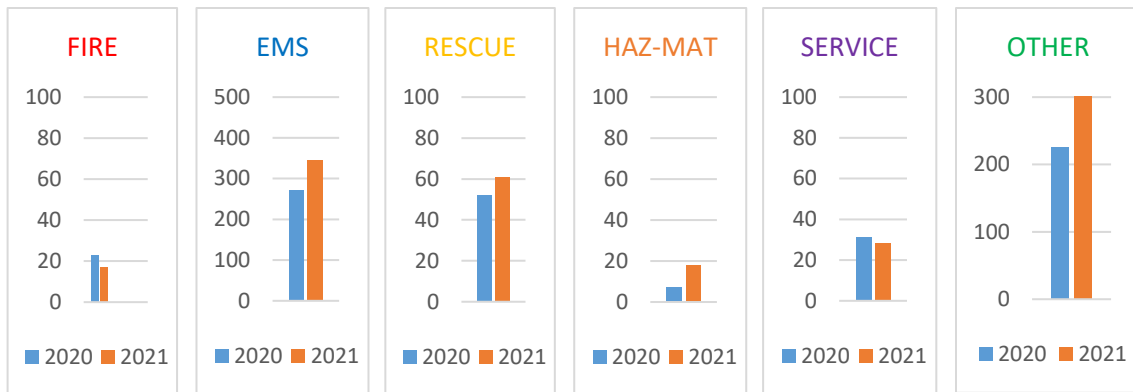
- 08/05/2021 Fire Marshal Stafford conducted a Hurricane and Fire Safety public event with the Isle of Palms Police Department at the Wild Dunes Property Owner's Beach House.
- 08/17/2021 Fire crews responded to a report of a Structure Fire on Pelican Reach. Upon arrival, Firefighters were met by the homeowners who stated that they saw flames coming from a bathroom vent. One of the homes residents used a fire extinguisher to put the fire out. Fire Department personnel found the area of origin. There was no active fire at the time. Firefighters checked the area for any fire extension, but found none. The breaker for the vent was secured and the homeowner was informed not to restore power to the vent until it could be fixed. All units cleared from the scene and returned back to service.
- 08/19/2021 City Administrator Fragoso, Police Chief Cornett, and Deputy Chief Hathaway attended the August 2021 Mount Pleasant Chamber of Commerce luncheon. Firefighter Puckhaber was recognized for his actions during a traumatic Injury call which occurred on July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
- 08/28/2021 Fire crews responded to a Motor Vehicle Accident on the Isle of Palms Connector. The accident consisted of two vehicles. The front end damage of the rear vehicle required the battery to be disconnected and the use of oil dry to clean up leaking fluids. The passenger in the front vehicle was treated for injuries and fire personnel assisted with patient packaging and loading for transport by Charleston County EMS. All units cleared from the scene and returned back to service.
- 08/30/2021 Fire crews responded to a Motor Vehicle Accident at Waterway Boulevard and 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue. Upon arrival, fire personnel found a truck had struck and split a palm tree into two. The vehicle was found resting against a bush almost striking a home. The vehicle was occupied by one person who refused medical care from Charleston County EMS. The vehicle was secured and turned over to law enforcements. All units cleared from the scene and returned back to service.

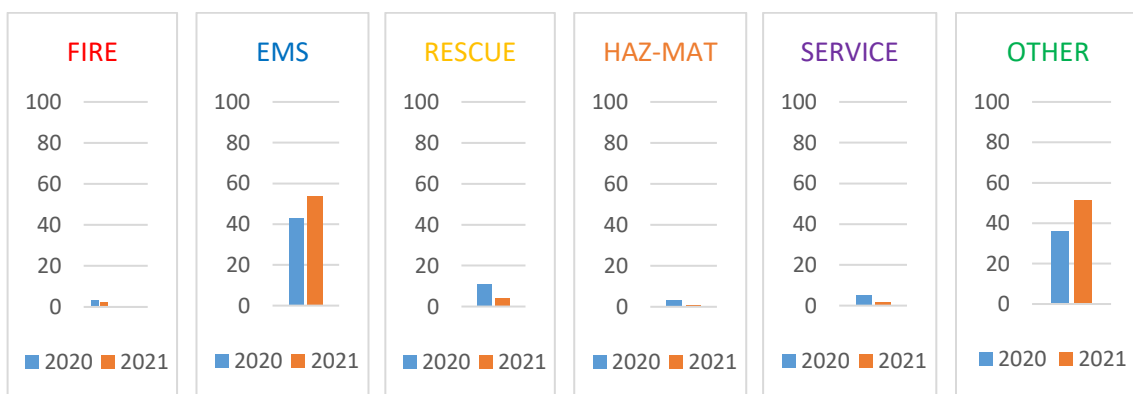

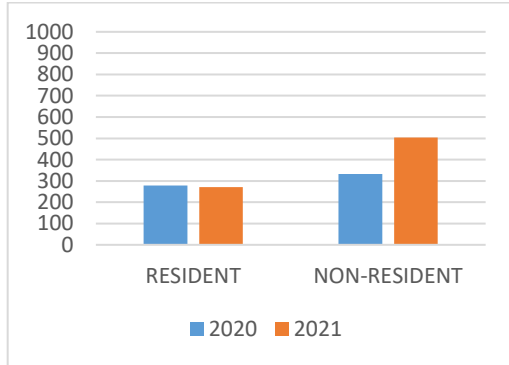

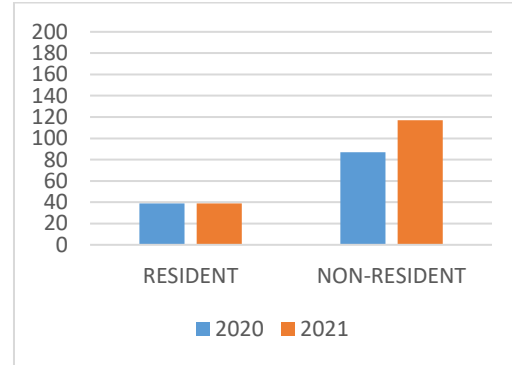
### RESIDENCY TYPE ANALYTIC COMPARISONS

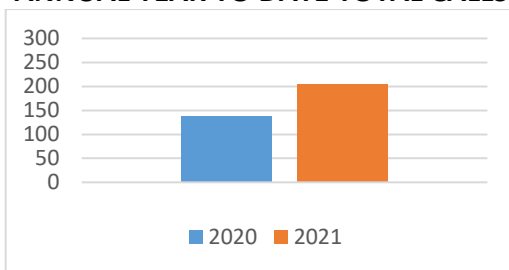

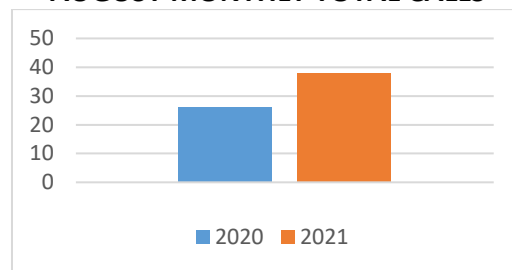
### TOTAL CALLS IN WILD DUNES

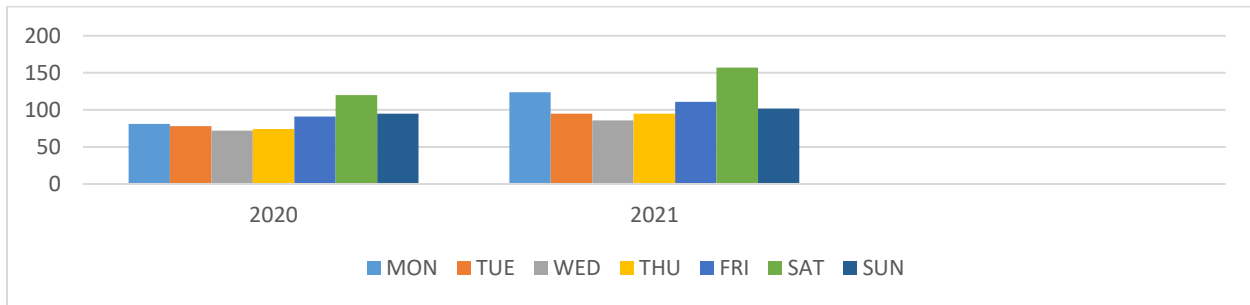

### AUGUST 2021 EMS Calls

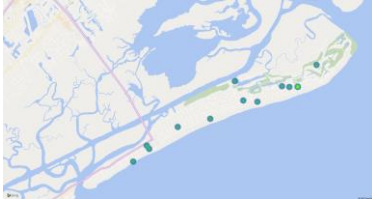




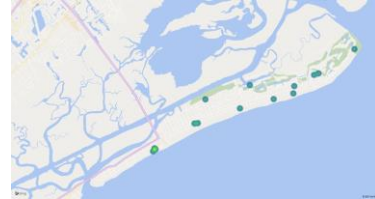

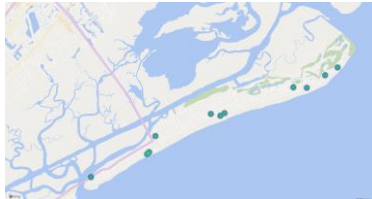
**AUGUST 2021 Sunday Calls**

### AUGUST 2021 Resident Calls

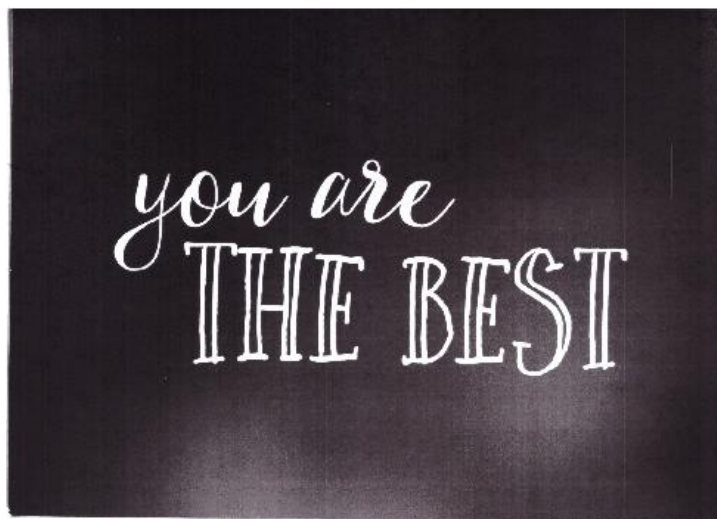


### AUGUST 2021 Non-Resident Calls
