Application for Parade Permit

A person seeking the issuance of a parade permit shall file an application with the Chief of Police not less than fifteen (15) days before the date on which it is proposed to conduct the parade and not less than thirty (30) days before the date on which it is proposed to conduct the parade if the number of anticipated participants exceeds one hundred (100). A \$25.00 nonrefundable application fee must be submitted with the application (Payment must be made payable to the City of Isle of Palms). This application complies with City of Isle of Palms Ordinance 3-1-43.

<u>Late Applications</u>: Where good cause is shown, the Chief of Police shall have the authority to consider any application which if filed in less than the required periods applicable for the size of parade proposed.
