The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of January.

Monday, January 2

Traffic Stop – IOP Connector

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 85MPH in a posted 55MPH speed zone. Further investigation revealed that the driver had a suspended driver's license. Additionally, the officer located marijuana, drug paraphernalia and an insulated cup containing liquor inside the vehicle. The driver was arrested and transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Tuesday, January 3

Grand Larceny – 5800 Block of Palmetto Drive

A victim reported that unknown persons stole several tennis racquets from the Tennis Center. The approximate value of the stolen items is \$2,025. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Trespassing – 600 Block Ocean Boulevard

Officers responded to a report of a suspicious subject trespassing on a construction site. The subject was located on the property and it was confirmed that he did not have permission to be on the property. The subject was arrested and transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Wednesday, January 4

Driving Under the Influence – Waterway Boulevard / 26th Avenue

An officer stopped a vehicle for multiple moving violations. Upon making contact with the driver, it was determined that he was possibly under the influence. The officer requested the driver to submit to Standardized Field Sobriety Tests, which at their conclusion, was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to the IOPPSB for Datamaster Testing, where he provided a breath sample registering a BAC of .32%. The driver was lodged in the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Thursday, January 5

Traffic Stop / DUI / Simple Possession of Marijuana – Palm Boulevard / Carolina Boulevard

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 90MPH in a posted 35MPH speed zone. Further investigation revealed that the driver was possibly under the influence. The officer requested the driver to submit to Standardized Field Sobriety Tests, which at their conclusion, was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to the IOPPSB for Datamaster Testing, where he was not able to provide a breath sample. Additionally, the officer located marijuana, an altered driver's license and drug paraphernalia inside the vehicle. The driver was charged with multiple violations and lodged in the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Sunday, January 8

Burglary – 26th Avenue

A victim reported that unknown persons entered his residence and stole a television from his enclosed back porch. The approximate value of the stolen item is \$600. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Thursday, January 12

Petit Larceny – 2700 Block of Hartnett Boulevard

A victim reported that he had incorrectly shipped items to his old address and when he made contact with the current residence, they refused to give him the items. The approximate value of the stolen items is \$246. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Friday, January 13

Burglary – 600 Block of Ocean Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown persons entered into the rental property and stole several bottles of liquor from a secured closet. The approximate value of the items stolen is \$487. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Wednesday, January 18

False Pretense / Confidence Game – 100 Block of Charleston Boulevard

A victim reported that he received an email from PayPal indicating that he needed to update his account information. After providing the necessary information, an unauthorized charge of \$139 was made to his credit card. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Monday, January 23

Traffic Stop / Narcotics Violation – 1200 Block of Palm Boulevard

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 50MPH in a posted 35MPH speed zone. Further investigation revealed an odor of marijuana emitting from the vehicle. The driver did not have a driver's license and provided the officer a fictitious name and date of birth. Additionally, the passenger, who was the owner of the vehicle, was in possession of Schedule II narcotics. Both subjects were arrested and transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Saturday, January 28

Driving Under the Influence – Palm Boulevard / 21st Avenue

An officer observed a vehicle stopped in the turn lane from the IOP Connector, which did not proceed through the green traffic signal. Further investigation revealed that the driver was possibly under the influence. The officer requested the driver to submit to Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and upon conclusion of the tests, was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to IOPPSB for Datamaster Testing, where he provided a breath sample that registered a BAC of .11%. The driver was lodged in the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Driving Under the Influence – Palm Boulevard / 3rd Avenue

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 47MPH in a posted 35MPH speed zone. Upon making contact with the driver, it was determined that he was possibly under the influence. The officer requested the driver submit to Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and upon conclusion of the tests, was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to the IOPPSB for Datamaster Testing, where he refused to provide a breath sample. The driver was lodged in the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Sunday, January 29

Driving Under the Influence – IOP Connector

An officer stopped a vehicle for multiple moving violations. Upon making contact with the driver, it was determined that he was possibly under the influence. When asked, the driver admitted to drinking four liquor drinks earlier. The officer requested the driver submit to Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and upon conclusion of the tests, was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to the IOPPSB for Datamaster Testing, where he provided a breath sample that registered a BAC of .18%. The driver was lodged in the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Driving Under the Influence – IOP Connector / Palm Boulevard

An officer responded to a report of a possible intoxicated driver and while patrolling for the vehicle, located it stopped in the turn lane on the IOP Connector. The driver was observed to be slumped over at the steering wheel. The officer requested the driver submit to Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and upon conclusion of the tests, was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to the IOPPSB for Datamaster Testing, where he refused to provide a breath sample. The driver was lodged in the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Tuesday, January 31

Grand Larceny – Waterway Island Drive

Officers responded to a report of a subject who had stolen items from the victim and was walking away from the residence. An officer located the subject and stayed with him until further information could be provided. The victim reported that the subject who was working for a moving company that had been hired was seen going through her car and noticed that an item from her purse was on the floor. When she confronted the subject, he removed some jewelry from his pocket and then started walking away. The subject was placed under arrest and the officer recovered more jewelry and cash that the subject had taken. The approximate value of the items stolen was \$128,000 and \$400 in cash. The subject was lodged in the Al Cannon Detention Center.
