The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of January.

Monday, January 1

Traffic Stop / Simple Possession Marijuana – Palm Boulevard / 30th Avenue

An officer stopped a vehicle for a moving violation. During contact with the driver, the officer asked if there was anything illegal in the car. The driver admitted to having marijuana in her backpack. A search of the vehicle resulted in the officer locating the marijuana and drug paraphernalia, which was taken as evidence. The driver was charged and issued a citation in the Isle of Palms Municipal Court.

Destructive / Damage / Vandalism of Property – 500 Block Palm Boulevard

A victim reported that someone had damaged the hood of her car and left blood was on the driver's side mirror. The victim was able to provide the officer with information on a possible suspect. The estimated amount of damage caused is \$1,000. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Wednesday, January 3

Simple Assault – 3400 Block Hartnett Boulevard

A victim reported that a subject staying in the residence struck her and pushed her to the ground, hitting her head repeatedly against the floor. Officers observed physical injury to the victim. The male subject told officers that he was trying to defend himself, but refused to elaborate. The officer placed the male subject under arrest for assault and battery 3rd degree and transported him to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Monday, January 8

False Pretense / Swindle / Confidence Game – 2600 Block Cameron Boulevard

A victim reported that she received a phone call from someone claiming to be her grandson, Michael, and was asking for money. The victim explained that she does not have a grandson named Michael. The victim was able to provide the phone number from her caller ID. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Tuesday, January 9

Disorderly Conduct – 1400 Block Ocean Boulevard

An officer responded to a report of a male subject stumbling around into traffic. The officer located the subject, who smelled strongly of alcohol, could not respond to the questions and refused to give any identification information to the officer. The subject was placed under arrest for disorderly conduct and was able to be released to his wife.

Wednesday, January 10

Driving Under Suspension – Palm Boulevard / 41st Avenue

An officer stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. When asked, the driver told the officer that he did not have his driver's license with him. Further investigation determined that the driver's license was suspended for failure to pay a traffic ticket. The driver was issued a citation for the Isle of Palms Municipal Court.

Theft from Motor Vehicle – 41st Avenue

A victim reported that an unknown person broke into his unlocked vehicle and stole prescriptions for his daughter's medication. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Thursday, January 11

Theft from Motor Vehicle – 22nd Avenue

A victim reported that an unknown person entered her unlocked car during the night and the next morning she found the glove compartment open, but it did not appear that anything had been stolen. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

**This was the 9th residence that we responded to for reports of vehicle break-ins in the general area. Nothing appeared to be taken from any of the vehicles, the vehicles were unlocked, but none of the owners wished to file a formal incident report.

Theft from Buildings – 2600 Block Waterway Boulevard

A victim reported that a firearm had been stolen from his residence and he believed that it was a friend that had recently visited. The victim was unable to provide a serial number for the firearm. The approximate value of the stolen item is \$400. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Friday, January 12

Driving Under Suspension – Palm Boulevard / 21st Avenue

An officer stopped a vehicle for having an expired vehicle license plate. Further investigation found that the driver's license was suspended and the vehicle was not insured. The driver was issued citations for the Isle of Palms Municipal Court.

Theft from Motor Vehicle – 24th Avenue

A victim reported that sometime during the night, someone entered his unlocked vehicle and stole his checkbook. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Saturday, January 13

Fraud / Identity Theft – 22nd Avenue

A victim reported that she had received a letter from her bank indicating that a new debit card had arrived. The victim had not requested a new debit card and called the bank, learning that someone had applied for the card online. The address to where the card was to be mailed was a local address of a subject the victim knows. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Sunday, January 14

Drug Equipment Violations – Palmetto Drive / Racquet Club Drive

An officer responded to a report of trespassers in the parking lot of the golf clubhouse. Upon locating two subjects, the officer could smell alcohol and determined that the subjects were underage. A case of beer was observed on the back seat along with an open beer that had spilled onto the floorboard. A pipe with marijuana residue was found in the center console. The two subjects were charged with unlawful possession of drug paraphernalia and underage possession of beer. They were issued citations for the Isle of Palms Municipal Court.

Monday, January 15

Destructive / Damage / Vandalism of Property – 41st Avenue

A victim reported that while her vehicle was legally parked, someone vandalized her car by puncturing the radiator and draining the oil. The victim provided information to the officer of a possible suspect. The approximate amount of damage to the vehicle is \$800. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Tuesday, January 16

Petit Larceny – Charleston Boulevard / Palm Boulevard

A victim reported that an unknown person had stolen the City's Christmas decorations that had been dismantled and set aside to be picked up. The decorations were the Happy Holidays with the snowman with multiple colored lights. The estimated value of the stolen item is \$500. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Saturday, January 20

Traffic Stop / Underage Possession – Palm Boulevard / 9th Avenue

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 50MPH in a posted 35MPH speed zone. While speaking with the driver, the officer saw several Smirnoff Ice alcoholic beverages on the back seat and that the driver was under 21 years old. When asked about the beverages, the driver said they were his father's, but he was taking them to a friend's house. Further investigation located the receipts from where the beverages were purchased and the driver's fake ID. The driver was issued citations for speeding, underage possession, and possession of a false ID for the Isle of Palms Municipal Court.

Monday, January 22

Driving Under Suspension – Palm Boulevard / 9th Avenue

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 47MPH in a posted 35MPH speed zone. During a check of the driver's information, it was determined that the driver's license was suspended. The driver was charged with DUS 2nd offense with a citation for the Isle of Palms Municipal Court.

Tuesday, January 23

Suspicious Vehicle / Simple Possession of Marijuana – Ocean Boulevard / Pavilion Drive

An officer on night shift got out to check on a vehicle parked with a subject sitting inside. While speaking with the occupant, the officer smelled marijuana emitting from inside the car. A search of the vehicle located the marijuana in the sunglasses holder. The subject was charged and issued a citation for the Isle of Palms Municipal Court.

Friday, January 26

Traffic Stop / Simple Possession of Marijuana – 41st Avenue / Waterway Boulevard

An officer stopped a vehicle for the driver not wearing his seatbelt and a moving violation. While speaking with the driver, the officer asked if there was anything illegal in the car and the driver admitted to having a pipe with marijuana in the center console. The subject was charged with simple possession of marijuana and operating an uninsured vehicle with citations for the Isle of Palms Municipal Court.

Saturday, January 27

Traffic Stop / Weapon Law Violations – 41st Avenue / Forest Trail

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 34MPH in a posted 25MPH speed zone. While speaking with the driver, the officer observed a strong odor of marijuana emitting from the vehicle and saw a box of bullets sitting on the passenger's seat. A search of the vehicle located a loaded handgun under the driver's front seat. The driver was placed under arrest for unlawful carrying of a firearm and transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Suspicious Vehicle / Simple Possession of Marijuana – 21st Avenue / Palm Boulevard

An officer observed a vehicle that had an invalid license plate, which did not match the make and model of the car it was physically attached. While speaking with the occupant, he admitted to putting the wrong tag on the car because the correct tag had been stolen. The occupant was not able to provide any documentation to verify this claim. The occupant became uncooperative and when officers attempted to detain him, he would not remove his balled-up fist from his jacket pocket and he was observed to be attempting to destroy marijuana. The subject was placed under arrest, charged with simple possession of marijuana, DUS for DUI 2nd offense, open container of beer, hindering police and transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Sunday, January 28

Petit Larceny – 3900 Block Hartnett Boulevard

A victim reported that he had provided a subject a cab ride to her home and when he attempted to charge her credit card for the \$89 fare, it was declined. The female subject got out of the car and walked down the street, ducking into the bushes. While officers were speaking with the victim, the female subject walked back up and asked if she could pay with cash, which she told them to use her credit card. The female subject was arrested for petit larceny and transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Monday, January 29

Fraudulent Credit Card – 1100 Block Palm Boulevard

A victim reported that unauthorized charges had been made on his credit card in the amount of \$1,039. The victim reported this information to his bank and a hold was placed on his card. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Fraudulent Credit Card – 41st Avenue

A victim reported that unauthorized charges had been made on her credit card through her PayPal account in the amount of \$998. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Community Service Activities

During the month of January 2018, Officers issued one hundred seventy-three (173) "Property Security Check Notices" and nineteen (19) "You Could Have Been a Victim of a Crime" notices.
