The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of December.

Saturday, December 2

<u>Traffic Offense</u> – IOP Connector

An officer stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. After contacting the driver, it was determined that the vehicle was uninsured. The driver was arrested and issued a citation with a court date in the East Cooper Magistrate Court.

Driving Under Suspension- 41st Avenue / Palm Boulevard

An officer stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. After contacting the driver, it was determined that the driver did not possess a valid driver's license. The driver was arrested for driving under suspension, failure to pay a traffic ticket and no driver's license. The driver was issued a citation with a court date in the Isle of Palms Municipal Court.

Sunday, December 3

Destructive/Damage/Vandalism of Property – Whispering Palms Lane

A victim reported that unknown persons entered the construction site of a residence and painted inappropriate words and pictures on the subflooring. The approximate amount of damage is \$25. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

<u>Driving Under Suspension</u>- Palm Boulevard / 6th Avenue

An officer stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. After contacting the driver, it was determined that the driver's license was suspended. The driver was arrested for DUS for DUI, failure to pay a traffic ticket and operating an uninsured vehicle. The driver was issued citations and given a court date in the Isle of Palms Municipal Court.

Tuesday, December 5

False Pretense/Swindle/Confidence Game - Morgans Cove Drive

A victim reported that he was contacted by an unknown person telling him that his grandson was in jail and money was needed to bail him out. The unknown subject identified himself as his grandson's

lawyer. The victim contacted his grandson and learned that the call was a fake. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Wednesday, December 6

Burglary - Sea Shell Lane

A victim reported that unknown persons entered the residence without permission and found that a television was missing from the living room and that the television from the bedroom had been placed by the back door. CID was called out to assist in the investigation. The victim was able to provide a serial number for the television, which was entered into NCIC. The approximate value of the stolen item is \$300. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Extortion/Blackmail - Ocean Point

A victim reported that he received a letter from an unknown person threatening to tell secret to his wife and family if he did not pay a "confidentiality fee" of \$3,500 in Bitcoin. The victim was unaware of any type of information that would cause harm to him or his family. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Driving Under Suspension - IOP Connector

An officer stopped a vehicle for a vehicle registration violation. After contacting the driver, it was determined that the driver's license was suspended and the vehicle license was suspended for failure to pay property taxes. The driver was arrested and issued a citation for DUS 2nd offense with a court date in the Isle of Palms Municipal Court.

Simple Possession of Marijuana - 100 Block Palm Boulevard

An officer stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. While speaking with the occupants of the vehicle, the officer observed an odor of marijuana emitting from inside the vehicle. When asked, the driver stated that he does not smoke marijuana, but his brother had previously used his car. The officer conducted a probable cause search of the vehicle and the occupants. During this search, one of the passengers was found with a baggie of marijuana concealed in his pants, another passenger was concealing a baggie of marijuana inside a clear plastic cup, and a grinder containing marijuana was found in the driver's side door. All subjects were placed under arrest, issued citations and transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Friday, December 8

Driving Under the Influence - Hartnett Boulevard / 29th Avenue

An officer stopped a vehicle for several moving violations. As the officer was approaching the vehicle, he observed the driver to move from the driver seat to the rear passenger seat and he was the only occupant in the vehicle. Upon contacting the driver, it was determined that he was possibly under the influence. The officer requested that the driver complete the Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and the driver agreed. At the completion of the tests, the driver was placed under arrest and transported to the IOPPSB for Datamaster Testing, where he would not cooperate and did not provide a proper breath sample, which provided incomplete results. It was also determined that the driver's license was suspended. The driver was charged with DUS for DUI and DUI, then transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Theft from Motor Vehicle - 800 Block Ocean Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown person(s) entered his car causing the alarm to go off. When the victim looked outside, he observed the door to his daughter's car open. The victim was able to provide surveillance video from his home camera system of a possible suspect. At this time, the victim was unable to determine if anything had been stolen from his daughter's car. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Theft from Motor Vehicle - 100 Block Carolina Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown person(s) entered his unlocked vehicle, went through his glovebox, throwing papers around. The victim was unable to determine if anything had been stolen. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Theft from Motor Vehicle - 500 Block Ocean Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown person(s) entered his unlocked vehicle, leaving the door and glovebox open. The victim was unable to determine if anything had been stolen. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Monday, December 11

Drug/Narcotic Violations - 21st Avenue / Palm Boulevard

An officer was patrolling for a vehicle that was being driven by a subject with an outstanding arrest warrant for receiving stolen goods with the Mt. Pleasant Police Department. The officer located the vehicle and conducted a traffic stop, identifying the driver as the subject with the outstanding arrest warrant. The subject was placed under arrest and during a search of the subject, a plastic baggie containing what appeared to be and field tested positive as heroin. The subject was turned over to Mt. Pleasant Police and a hold was placed on him at the Al Cannon Detention Center for warrants with our agency for the possession of heroin.

Wednesday, December 13

Grand Larceny – 46th Avenue

A victim reported that while construction was being done on his residence, unknown person(s) entered the open area under the residence and stole furniture that was covered with tarps and being stored. The approximate value of the stolen items is \$5,000. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Thursday, December 14

Driving Under Suspension - 34th Avenue / Hartnett Boulevard

An officer responded to a report of a suspicious vehicle that was driving in the neighborhood very slowly and stopping in front of different houses. Upon locating the vehicle, the officer observed the vehicle driving and then stop, with the driver getting out and walking up to the officer. The officer explained the report of the suspicious vehicle and asked for the driver's identification. Upon checking the driver's license, it was determined that the license was suspended. The driver was placed under arrest and issued a citation with a court date in the Isle of Palms Municipal Court and the vehicle was towed.

<u>Domestic Violence</u> – 6000 Block of Back Bay Drive

Officers responded to a report of a domestic violence situation. Upon arrival, it was determined that a male and female who are dating and currently living together began arguing, which became physical. Investigation determined that the female half became angry about a women the male half had been talking with when they had broken up. The female half threw a glass of wine at the male and then slapped him in the face. The female was placed under arrest and charged with domestic violence 3rd offense and resisting arrest as she pushed an officer and attempted to pull away. The female was transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Friday, December 15

Breach of Trust - Fairway Village Lane

A victim reported that a subject he was in business with withdrew all the money from the joint checking account without his knowledge or authorization. The total amount of money taken was \$7,290. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Saturday, December 16

<u>Destructive/Damage/Vandalism of Property</u> – 2600 Block Palm Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown person(s) had broken her mailbox and split into two pieces. The approximate value of the damaged property is \$100. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Sunday, December 17

Driving Under the Influence – IOP Connector

An officer stopped a vehicle for moving violations. Further investigation determined that the driver was possibly under the influence. When asked, the driver indicated that she drank four drinks during a Christmas party. The officer requested the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and after the tests, was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to IOPPSB for Datamaster testing, where she refused to provide a breath sample. The driver was transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Monday, December 18

<u>Driving Under Suspension</u> – 100 Block Palm Boulevard

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 45MPH in a posted 35MPH speed zone. Upon checking the driver's license, it was determined that his license was suspended for failing to report a collision. The driver was arrested, issued a citation with a court date in the Isle of Palms Municipal Court.

Wednesday, December 20

Traffic Offense - Palm Boulevard / Palmetto Drive

An officer responded to a collision involving two vehicles. Further investigation revealed that one of the drivers did not possess a valid driver's license. The driver was arrested and transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Saturday, December 23

Simple Possession of Marijuana – IOP Connector

An officer stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. During contact with the driver, the officer detected an odor of marijuana emitting from within the vehicle. When asked, the driver indicated that he brother had used his vehicle earlier. As a result of a probable cause search, the officer located a quantity of marijuana and drug paraphernalia inside the glove box. The driver was arrested, issued citations and given a court date in the Isle of Palms Municipal Court.

Sunday, December 24

Grand Larceny - Palm Court

A victim reported that unknown person(s) broke into the secured owner's closet in the rental property and stole various dishes, serving trays, and glasses. The approximate value of the items stolen is \$10,455. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.
