The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of November.

Sunday, November 1

Petit Larceny – 41st Avenue

A victim reported that unknown person(s) boarded his boat and stole a cooler valued at approximately \$400. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Petit Larceny – 500 Block Palm Boulevard

A victim reported that a known subject entered into his residence and stole a refrigerator, shed, screen door and glass door. The value of the stolen items is approximately \$1600. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Driving Under the Influence – Palm Boulevard / 8th Avenue

An Officer stopped a vehicle for a license plate violation. During contact with the driver, it was determined that she was possibly under the influence. When asked, the driver indicated that she had only had one beer. The Officer requested the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety Test and at the conclusion was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to the IOPPSB for DMT Testing, where she provided a breath sample that registered a .16% BAC. The driver was lodged in the Charleston Count Detention Center.

Monday, November 2

Burglary – 8500 Block Palmetto Drive

A victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into their residence and stole a television and comforter. The residence was not occupied and is a rental property. The estimated value of the items stolen is approximately \$300. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Wednesday, November 4

Traffic Offense – Simple Possession of Marijuana – IOP Connector

An Officer stopped a vehicle for a license plate violation. During further investigation arrested the driver for a suspended driver's license. While conducting a pre-tow inventory of the vehicle, the Officer

located a quantity of marijuana, which was determined to belong to the vehicle's passenger. The passenger was arrested and lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

Sunday, November 8

Warrant Arrest – Ocean Boulevard / 10th Avenue

An Officer stopped a vehicle for a moving violation. Further investigation revealed that one of the passengers had an active arrest warrant with Clarendon County Sheriff's Office for possession of marijuana. Once the warrant was confirmed, the subject was placed under arrest and transported to the Charleston County Detention Center.

Tuesday, November 10

Driving Under the Influence – IOP Connector

An Officer stopped a vehicle for moving violations and upon making contact with the driver, determined that he was possibly under the influence. Before the Officer could explain the reason for the stop, the driver was stating that he was going to jail. The Officer requested that the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests, but he refused and was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to the IOPPSB for DMT Testing where he refused to provide a breath sample. The driver was lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

Shoplifting – 1500 Block Palm Boulevard

Officers responded to a report of suspicious persons at the back of the Island Center Shopping Center and immediately located the subjects. At that point it was determined that the subjects had been inside the store and stole items without paying for them. The subjects were arrested and lodged at the Charleston County Detention Center.

Thursday, November 12

Traffic Offense – Drug/Narcotic Violations – IOP Connector

An Officer stopped a vehicle for a speeding violation, 71MPH in a 55MPH speed zone. During contact with the occupants of the vehicle, the Officer could see in plain view a clear plastic bag containing various pills, which were identified as Schedule I and IV drugs. The Officer asked the driver for consent to search the vehicle and placed the driver, who was being detained, in the back seat of the patrol vehicle. When the driver was removed from the patrol vehicle and the back seat was checked, a clear plastic bag containing what field-tested positive as heroin was located. The driver was arrested and lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

Saturday, November 14

Disorderly Conduct – 900 Block Ocean Boulevard

An Officer on patrol observed a male subject stumbling down the sidewalk and turned around to make contact with the subject. When the Officer located the subject, he was urinating in the bushes. The subject was intoxicated and unable to tell the Officer where he was staying or provide anyone to contact. The subject was arrested and lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

Driving Under the Influence – Palm Boulevard / 5th Avenue

An Officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 48MPH in a 35MPH speed zone. Upon making contact with the driver, it was determined that he was possibly under the influence. When asked, the driver admitted to having several drinks. The Officer requested that the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and at the conclusion of the testing, was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to the IOPPSB for DMT Testing, where he refused to provide a breath sample. The driver was lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

Sunday, November 15

Warrant Arrest – 1500 Block Palm Boulevard

An Officer responded to a local grocery store in reference to a suspicious subject who was attempting to shoplift. The Officer made contact with the subject and determined that he had an outstanding arrest warrants with three (3) different agencies. The subject was transferred to Berkeley County Sheriff's Office for one of the arrest warrants. The other agencies were contacted regarding his location.

Monday, November 16

Petit Larceny – 5800 Block Palmetto Drive

A victim reported that unknown person(s) stole a LCD Projector from the conference center. The value of the stolen item is approximately \$1500. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Tuesday, November 17

Vandalism – 9500 Block Palmetto Drive

A victim reported that unknown person(s) broke the code box for the entry gate. The estimated cost of the damage is approximately \$800. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Thursday, November 19

Driving Under the Influence – IOP Connector

An Officer stopped a vehicle for a moving violation and upon making contact with the driver determined that he was possibly under the influence. When asked, the driver admitted to drinking four or five beers at a friend's house. The Officer requested that the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety Test and at the conclusion of the testing was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to IOPPSB for DMT Testing, where the driver provided a breath sample that registered .12% BAC. The driver was lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

Friday, November 20

Vandalism – 28th Avenue – IOP Recreation Department

A victim reported that unknown person(s) damaged Christmas lights by cutting the wires and caused gouges in the tennis court. The estimated amount of damage is approximately \$500. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Monday, November 23

Driving Under the Influence – Hwy. 517 / IOP Connector

An Officer stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. Upon making contact with the driver, it was determined that he was possibly under the influence. When asked, the driver indicated that he had had maybe two beers. The Officer requested that the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety Test and at the completion of the testing was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to the IOPPSB for DMT Testing, where he refused to provide a breath sample. The driver was lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

Petit Larceny – 1200 Block Palm Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown person(s) stole an inflatable Thanksgiving decoration that was located outside in front of the building. The item stolen was valued at approximately \$50. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Tuesday, November 24

Petit Larceny – 1000 Block Carolina Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown person(s) stole her son's bicycle from the driveway. The item stolen is valued at approximately \$150. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Driving Under the Influence – Palm Boulevard / 11th Avenue

An Officer stopped a vehicle for multiple moving violations. Upon making contact with the driver, it was determined that she was possibly under the influence. When asked, the driver denied drinking anything alcoholic. The Officer requested that the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and at the completion of the testing was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to IOPPSB for DMT Testing, where she provided a breath sample with a .06% BAC. It was suspected that the driver was under the influence of a substance other than alcohol and a Drug Recognition Expert was requested to complete an evaluation. The testing determined that she was under the influence of alcohol and cannabis. The driver was taken to a local hospital to provide a urine sample and then lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

Friday, November 27

Driving Under the Influence – H.L. Hunley Bridge

An Officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 46MPH in a 35MPH posted speed zone. Upon contact with the driver, it was determined that he was possibly under the influence. When asked, the driver indicated that he had two glasses of wine earlier. The Officer requested that the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and at the conclusion was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to the IOPPSB for DMT Testing where he refused to provide a breath sample. The driver was lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

Saturday, November 28

DUI / Simple Possession of Marijuana – IOP Connector

An Officer stopped a vehicle for speeding 71MPH in a 55MPH posted speed zone. Upon making contact with the driver, it was determined that he was possibly under the influence. When asked, the driver indicated that he had either one or two drinks at a local bar. The Officer requested that the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and at the conclusion was placed under arrest. During a pre-

tow of the vehicle, the Officer located a quantity of marijuana. The driver was transported to the IOPPSB for DMT Testing, where he provided a breath sample with a .13% BAC. The driver was lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

Sunday, November 29

Traffic Offense – Simple Possession of Marijuana – IOP Connector

An Officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 105MPH in a 55MPH posted speed zone. Upon contact with the occupants, the Officer asked if there was anything illegal in the vehicle and was told that there was marijuana. The Officer located the items, placed the occupants under arrest and released them to their parents.

Agency Assist – MVC – Back Bay Drive / Dune Ridge Lane

An Officer responded to a report of a motor vehicle collision with possible injuries. Upon arrival, the Officer located a heavily damaged vehicle, one occupant lying on the ground and another occupant was located shortly after arrival. It was determined that one of the occupants was deceased and the Charleston County Coroner's Office was notified. Charleston County Sheriff's Office was also requested to assist with the collision reconstruction investigation.

Personnel Recognition

Command Staff recognizes Pfc. Storen and Pfc. Maloney for their actions on November 1, 2015 when they responded to a suicidal subject who had climbed over the railing on the H.L. Hunley Bridge and was sitting on the piling over Breach Inlet. The Officers were able to develop a rapport with the subject to get her back over the railing to safety.

Community Service Activities

During the month of November 2015, Officers issued eighty-five (85) "Property Security Check Notices" and two (2) "You Could Have Been a Victim of a Crime" notices.

November 19, Pfc. Reynolds assisted a resident from Mt. Pleasant with a child seat installation/inspection.

November 21, Pfc. Couche assisted a resident from Awendaw with a child seat installation/inspection.

November 24 - Coffee With A Cop event was conducted at Harris Teeter from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. During the event officers interacted with approximately twenty-five residents.

November 25, Pfc. Couche assisted an island resident with a child seat installation/inspection.


