PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, starting on the 30th day of May 2020, in the aftermath of the killing of George Floyd, municipalities within the boundaries of Charleston County have been experiencing acts of violence and vandalism by a group of agitators which has caused property damage and threatened the safety of the citizens and;

WHEREAS, accordingly, a state of emergency does in fact, exist.

NOW THEREFORE, I, James E. Carroll, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Isle of Palms, do proclaim a state of emergency and invoke the provisions of Section 1-2-5 of the Code of Ordinances, the City of Isle of Palms, South Carolina.

AND, FURTHERMORE, all law enforcement officers of the County or State are authorized to enforce any such emergency ordinances within the City's corporate limits.
