**Sanitation:**

51.26 tons of C&D were transported to the Bees Ferry landfill. Of the total tonnage, 39.99 tons were post-Irma storm debris

**Overtime**

Operated Saturday full staff on 9/16 and 9/23 post-storm (Irma) debris operations.

Debris collected from 9/11/2017 thru 9/30/2017 – 251.96 tons

**Landscaping/Road Maintenance:**

Serviced the pooper-scoopers 5 times.

Cleaned the beach on September 1<sup>st</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>

Cleaned the Breach Inlet sidewalk

Mowed the right-of-way from 41<sup>st</sup> thru 57<sup>th</sup> and 45<sup>th</sup> Avenues to Cedar Street 2 times by HDR Services.

Cleaned the parking lot and compactor each Thursday in September  
Post-storm (Irma) emergency debris operations began 9/12/17 clearing the Beachwood East area roads of sand/debris.

Charleston County provided emergency street-sweeping on several areas of the Island including Ocean Blvd from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> Aves and Palm Blvd from 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave to 10<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> to 41<sup>st</sup> including the bicycle lanes.

**Stormwater:**

As part of hurricane preparations the Public Works Department staged 7 pumps throughout the island; 3 pumps on Palm Blvd and 4 pumps on the Avenues 46 thru 52<sup>nd</sup>.

The pumps were manned by Public Works as the Police Department notified Public Works for service both during and after the storm.

Pumping operations began on 9/11/17 and operated thru 9/26/17.

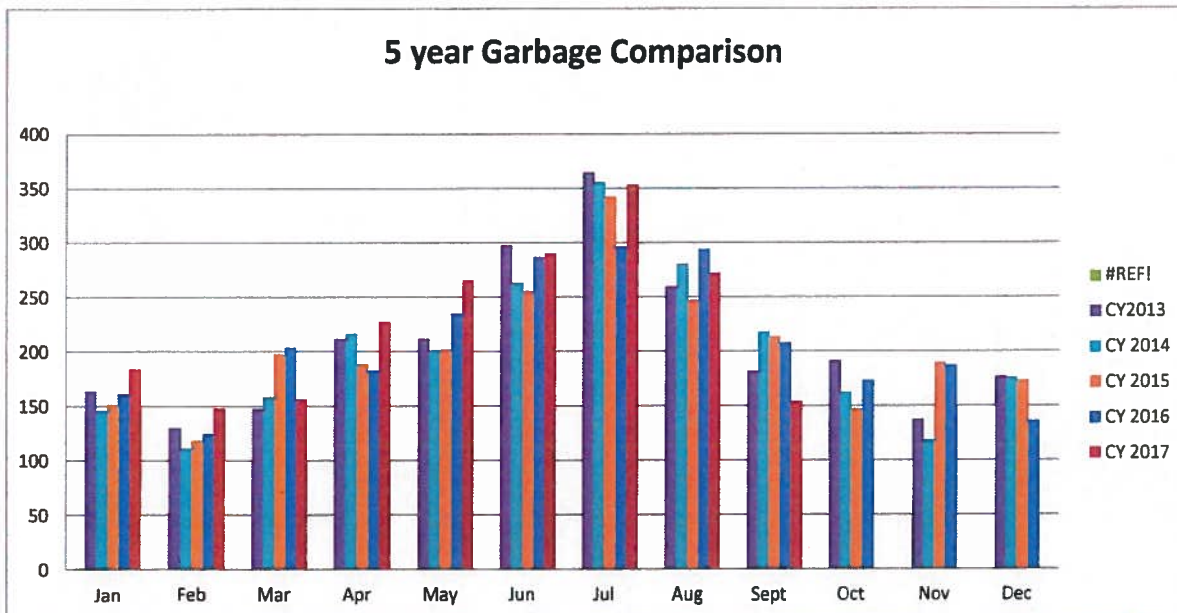
Eadies Drain and Vac provided emergency drain work in areas affected by flooding.
