#### HALLOWEEN GOLF CART COSTUME PARADE

- 1. All golf cart entries must register through the Recreation Department to participate.
- 2. Registration begins Monday, October 5 ends on Wednesday, October 28, 2020. No entries accepted after October 28.
- 3. Prizes will be awarded to the best three (3) carts in the parade.

# 4. NO MATERIALS MAY BE THROWN FROM OR TO GOLF CARTS ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE.

- 5. No spraying water, water balloons or any spraying of spectators of any kind.
- 6. Participants must stay on the cart, at all times throughout the parade route.
- 7. Golf carts must remain in motion. No stopping to talk with spectators.
- 8. A space of at least 15 feet between each golf cart will be enforced.
- Alcoholic beverages are forbidden in any golf cart, or on the person of participant.
  Participants consuming alcohol prior to or during the parade will be removed from the lineup.
- 10. Drivers of any and all vehicles in the parade area must possess a valid driver's license, be at least 16 years old, and possess all liability insurance.
- 11. **Pets may ride in golf cart parade and must stay inside the cart and secured at all times.** If pets are included, please identify when registering for participation. Please make sure your pet is well cared for and not startled by other participants or noises. Owners of pets are required to clean up after pets if necessary.
- 12. City Staff will withdraw any cart or individual that does not comply with the safety rules and regulations regarding the parade. Failure to comply with the instructions of City Officials will result in immediate removal from the parade and be disqualified from judging.
- 13. Costumes worn by parade participants must meet the standards of reasonable public taste. Costumes are to be family friendly.
- 14. Political Campaigning is not permitted. Politicians are welcome to participate in the parade but distribution or handing out of materials, flyers, etc. is not permitted.

## **GOLF CART LINEUP**

All golf cart entries will be assigned a line-up number and receive further instructions about the parade upon approval of registration.

All approved applicants will need to be at 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue parking area no later than 3:30 p.m. on Saturday, October 31<sup>st</sup>. Parade Day. Parade will begin promptly at 4:00 p.m. Enter the parade area from Waterway and 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

Changes in the parade line up the day of the parade will be at the sole discretion of designated event personnel.

## ROUTE

The parade will start from the assembly area on 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue moving up to Hartnett Boulevard where the parade will turn right on Hartnett, then right on 22<sup>nd</sup>, then right on Waterway then right on 29<sup>th</sup> then right on Hartnett and finally right on 28<sup>th</sup>. Golf carts may enter the drive through haunted house or chose to go around and exit at 28<sup>th</sup> and Hartnett.

Food trucks will be located on Hartnett between 28<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> Avenues for participants to stop and purchase foods on their way home.

NO RIDERS MAY DISMOUNT AT ANYTIME. All participants must remain on golf cart for duration of event.

## NO PARTICIPANT WILL STOP MOTION OF THE PARADE PROCESSION UNLESS SPECIFICALLY INSTRUCTED BY A CITY OFFICIAL AND/OR POLICE OFFICER.
