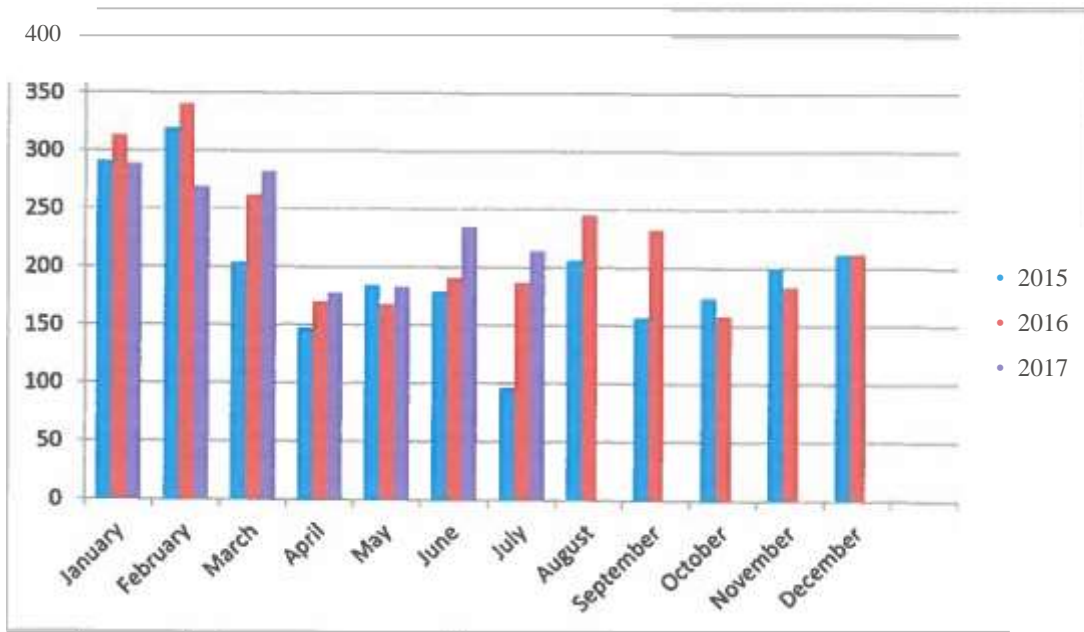
### **Holiday Street Festival**
