Securing three written quotes for installation of four (4) adjustable basketball goals to replace the existing outdoor basketball.


Installed new lights in Front Beach restrooms.

Removed old changing tables and installed new tables.


Patched holes in women's handicap stall at Front Beach restrooms.

Removed and installed old fans and mirrors in restrooms.


Working on a ½ mile walking trail around the perimeter of the Recreation grounds.




OVERALL 1ST FLOOR - EXISTING




2ND FLOOR - EXISTING





