

- Open sunrise to sunset.
- Enter and use the dog park at your own risk.
- Dog owners must be 18 years of age and may be accompanied by only one (1) child 12 or older.
- No children allowed in the dog park (must be 16 years old)
- All dogs must wear current rabies vaccination tags and other licenses as required by the City.
- Owners must clean up after their dogs using the scoops provided.
- Dispose of waste properly in the designated on site container.
- No more than three (3) dogs per person on any single visit.
- Owners must have one (1) leash per dog at all times.
- Puppies less than four (4) months old are not permitted in park.
- The Bark Park is subject to patrol by Animal Control, IOP Police Department and Park Staff.
- Aggressive dogs and/or female dogs in heat are not allowed.
- Professional dog trainers are not to use this area to conduct business
- South Carolina Law requires all dog bites to be reported to the Isle of Palms Police Department Animal Control Division.
- Owners are responsible for any injury or damage caused by their dog and are fully responsible for their actions.
- NO smoking, eating or drinking in the dog park area.
- Dogs must be leashed when entering and exiting the park.
- Animal Control will be called to collect any unattended dogs.
- The Bark Park is subject to patrol by Animal Control, IOP Police Department and Park Staff.
