



RESOLUTION

BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ISLE OF PALMS, SOUTH CAROLINA, APPROVING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR BEACH RESTORATION FUNDS, AND COMMITTING TO THE LOCAL FUNDING REQUIREMENTS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT SUBJECT TO THE CONTRACTUAL PARTICIPATION OF OTHER DESIGNATED PARTIES.

IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF ISLE OF PALMS, SOUTH CAROLINA, THAT:

WHEREAS, as a result of severe beach erosion caused primarily by the natural processes of a shoal attachment at the northeastern end of the Isle of Palms, a public and private emergency exists which affects the health and safety of the public and private property owners; and

WHEREAS, the City derives a public benefit from the private property and public beaches in the affected areas through the generation of real property taxes, accommodation and hospitality fees, and the public's use and enjoyment of the beaches; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to protect the health and safety of the public by trying to prevent infrastructure, sewer, and construction debris from being swept into the waters surrounding the City; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to submit an application for beach restoration funds to the State;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that City Council, in meeting duly assembled, approves the submittal of an application for beach restoration funds, and commits to the local funding requirements necessary to complete the project subject to the contractual participation of other designated parties.
