RESOLUTION

BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ISLE OF PALMS, SOUTH CAROLINA, TO ADOPT AN UPDATED LOCAL COMPREHENSIVE BEACH MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE CITY OF ISLE OF PALMS.

IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF ISLE OF PALMS, SOUTH CAROLINA, THAT:

WHEREAS,

the City of Isle of Palms, in accordance with the South Carolina Beachfront Management Act (SC Code Section 48-39-250 et seq.), did draft its initial Local Comprehensive Beach Management Plan in 2007, which was adopted by resolution on February 26, 2008 and approved by the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control's Office of Ocean and Coastal Resource Management (DHEC-OCRM) on April 7, 2008; and

WHEREAS,

pursuant to SC Code Section 48-39-350, the City of Isle of Palms is required to periodically update its Local Comprehensive Beach Management Plan in accordance with applicable South Carolina laws and regulations; and

WHEREAS,

the City of Isle of Palms has prepared an updated Local Comprehensive Beach Management Plan to be submitted to DHEC-OCRM for review and approval; and

WHEREAS,

the City of Isle of Palms believes its updated Local Comprehensive Beach Management Plan to be in the best interest of the City, in furtherance of its duty to protect the City's natural resources and in compliance with the provisions of the South Carolina Beachfront Management Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that City Council, in meeting duly assembled, hereby adopts the updated Local Comprehensive Beach Management Plan dated August 23, 2016, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
