RESOLUTION

BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ISLE OF PALMS, SOUTH CAROLINA, APPROVING THE LOCATION AND DESIGN OF COMMUNICATION TOWER FOR CITY PUBLIC SAFETY USES.

IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF ISLE OF PALMS, SOUTH CAROLINA, THAT:

WHEREAS, City Council recognizes the urgent need to facilitate improvement of radio

communications between firefighting, law enforcement, medical,

emergency and 911 personnel within the City.

WHEREAS, On April 26, 2011, City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2011-02, which

amends Title 5, Planning and Development, Chapter 4 Zoning, Article 1, General Provisions, Section 5-4-20(a), Communication tower and antennae regulations, to provide an exception from the City's zoning

regulations for communication towers for City public safety uses.

WHEREAS, The amended ordinance provides for certain additional requirements for

communication towers for City public safety uses, including the

requirement that the "applicant must obtain approval from City Council

for the location and design of the communication tower."

WHEREAS, Charleston County and Crown Castle presented plans for the design and

location of a communication tower for the City's public safety uses on

April 26, 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that City Council, in meeting duly assembled, approves the location and design of the public safety communication tower as presented.
