- The base bid quantity has been increased to a total of 1,000,000 cy. For Base Bid purposes, 650,000 cy will be placed in Reach 1 and 350,000 cy will be placed in Reach 2. The alternate quantity is reduced to 400,000 cy, therefore, the total project volume remains the same, ie Base + Alt Bid total of 1,400,000 cy. Bidder shall consider language in the summary of work in sections C-520 and C2230 to reflect the adjusted quantities. <u>Bidders shall used the attached</u> Revised Bid Form for the bid.
- 2) The Owner is adding an additional construction window of 1 October 2018 thru 30 March 2019 to be bided separately from the original window ending 30 March 2018. The additional window will be referred as Bid B in the revised Bid Form. The original window ending 30 March 2018 will be referred as Bid A in the revised Bid Form. Bidders do not have to bid both Bid A and Bid B to be eligible for the work. All blanks on the Bid Form shall be completed. "No Bid" may be entered if a bidder elects not to bid on either Bid A or Bid B.
- Recent survey data and GIS files have been placed on the dropbox folder at tinyurl.com/IOPNourishment. The survey data is in XYZ format (SC State Plane 3900 in NAVD 88) and covers the beach and offshore area encompassing the project area. The offshore data in and adjacent to the borrow areas was collected in August 2016 and the inshore and beach data was collected in May 2017.

1.02 The undersigned Bidder proposes and agrees, if this Bid is accepted, to enter into an Agreement with Owner in the form included in the Bidding Documents to perform all Work as specified or indicated in the Bidding Documents for the prices and within the times indicated in this Bid and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.

ARTICLE 2 – BIDDER'S ACKNOWLEDGMENTS

2.01 Bidder accepts all of the terms and conditions of the Instructions to Bidders, including without limitation those dealing with the disposition of Bid security. This Bid will remain subject to acceptance for 60 days after the Bid opening, or for such longer period of time that Bidder may agree to in writing upon request of Owner.

ARTICLE 3 – BIDDER'S REPRESENTATIONS

- 3.01 In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents that:
 - A. Bidder has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents, other related data identified in the Bidding Documents, and the following Addenda, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged:

- B. Bidder has visited the Site and become familiar with and is satisfied as to the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- C. Bidder is familiar with and is satisfied as to all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- D. Bidder has carefully studied all: (1) reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or contiguous to the Site and all drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site (except Underground Facilities) that have been identified in SC-4.02 as containing reliable "technical data," and (2) reports and drawings of Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at the Site that have been identified in SC-4.06 as containing reliable "technical data."
- E. Bidder has considered the information known to Bidder; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Bidding Documents; and the Site-related reports and drawings identified in the Bidding Documents, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and documents on (1) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (2) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder, including applying the specific means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction expressly required by the Bidding Documents; and (3) Bidder's safety precautions and programs.
- F. Based on the information and observations referred to in Paragraph 3.01.E above, Bidder does not consider that further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the determination of this Bid for performance of the Work at the price(s) bid and within the times required, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.
- G. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.

- H. Bidder has correlated the information known to Bidder, information and observations obtained from visits to the Site, reports and drawings identified in the Bidding Documents, and all additional examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, and data with the Bidding Documents.
- I. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Bidder.
- J. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance of the Work for which this Bid is submitted.

ARTICLE 4 – BIDDER'S CERTIFICATION

4.01 Bidder certifies that:

- A. This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed individual or entity and is not submitted in conformity with any collusive agreement or rules of any group, association, organization, or corporation;
- B. Bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid;
- C. Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding; and
- D. Bidder has not engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the Contract. For the purposes of this Paragraph 4.01.D:
 - 1. "corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of any thing of value likely to influence the action of a public official in the bidding process;
 - 2. "fraudulent practice" means an intentional misrepresentation of facts made (a) to influence the bidding process to the detriment of Owner, (b) to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels, or (c) to deprive Owner of the benefits of free and open competition;
 - 3. "collusive practice" means a scheme or arrangement between two or more Bidders, with or without the knowledge of Owner, a purpose of which is to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels; and
 - 4. "coercive practice" means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the bidding process or affect the execution of the Contract.

ARTICLE 5 – BASIS OF BID

- 5.01 Bidders are requested to provide bids for Bid A and/or Bid B for completion of the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents. Bids require all work (Mobilization/Demobilization, Base Volume Dredging and Placement, Alternate Volume Dredging and Placement, and Environmental Protection Measures) to be accomplished between <u>1 October 2017</u> and 30 March 2018 for Bid A and <u>1 October 2018 and 30 March 2019 for Bid B</u>. All blanks on the Bid Form shall be completed. "No Bid" may be entered if a bidder elects not to bid on either Bid A or Bid B.
- 5.02 The maximum Work allowed under federal and state permits is 1,400,000 cubic yards (cy) along a maximum of 10,800 linear feet of beach. The maximum excavation area allowed under federal and state permits is ~375 acres (aggregate) as identified on the Project Plans. The maximum excavation depth allowed under federal and state permits is 7 ft below existing grade plus 1 ft overdredge.

Within the permitted borrow areas, priority areas have been identified totaling ~195 acres and containing up to 2.2 million cubic yards of sand if excavated to 7 ft below existing grade. These areas shall be utilized first for this project. Excluded areas are also identified within the permitted borrow areas that were found to have unsuitable material after the permit was issued. Borrow Area I is not a priority borrow area and is pending a permit modification from the USACE.

- 5.03 Total volume of Work will be determined based on the combination of Base Bid quantity and Alternate Quantity which best suits the Owner's available funds.
- 5.04 Payment will be made for each cubic yard placed as verified by survey-in-place up to the final awarded volume. Payment will be for verified in-place cubic yards times a unit price.

- 6.01 Bidder agrees that the Base Bid A and Alternate Bid A (if applicable) Work will be substantially completed on or before 21 March 2018 for Work along the project area. All Work shall be completed and ready for final payment in accordance with paragraph 14.07.B of the General Conditions on or before 30 March 2018.
- 6.02 Bidder agrees that the Base Bid B and Alternate Bid B (if applicable) Work will be substantially completed on or before 21 March 2019 for Work along the project area. All Work shall be completed and ready for final payment in accordance with paragraph 14.07.B of the General Conditions on or before 30 March 2019.
- 6.03 Bidder accepts the provisions of the Agreement as to liquidated damages in the event of failure to complete the Work within the times specified above, which shall be stated in the Agreement.
- 6.04 The Contractor will be given additional time to complete the Work if delays are caused by declared natural disasters or late issuance of the Notice to Proceed in accordance with paragraph 12.03 of the General Conditions, only if all Work can still be completed by March 30, 2018 for Bid A or March 30, 2019 for Bid B. Otherwise, Contractor's remedies for delays are set forth in paragraph 12.03 of the Supplementary Conditions.
- 6.05 The Contractor may work twenty-four hours a day and seven days a week within the contract times.
